

Blu-By-U is an 8 acre Agritourism Farm with about 4000 U-Pick Blueberry bushes, 10 different varieties, all in large Containers on nicely maintained grass rows with plenty of room for picking and family fun. We are in a peaceful country setting so all you hear are birds, bees, wind, and laughter but not far from the City. Our goal and mission is to Celebrate Creation in the amazing process of getting Sweet Fruit from Sticks and Dirt. Our Hydroponics field has about 2000 Strawberry plants on Towers for easy picking and room for many more fruits and vegetables as we expand this area. We schedule Picking times on our website blubyujax.com so your experience on our farm will be free from lines and crowds. We supply the Buckets which hold about 5 pounds and berries are just \$6 per pound. Opening Day and Events will be posted on our Facebook page 'BluByUjax' and Thank You to all of our followers and volunteers as we work hard all year for our 6 week picking season which begins in Late April through the end of May. Our Country store has many locally produced products like Honey, Jams, Baked Goods, and Hot Sauce. We are a member of Fresh from Florida and Florida Blueberry Growers Association and help promote Pop Fusion which has some of the best Fresh Fruit popsicles I have ever tasted. We have a shaded Picnic area where you can bring your own food and various Food trucks during our picking season. Your kids will be amazingly entertained by our Sandbox and our farm is Dog friendly. Drinks Water, Snacks, Clean Restrooms, Access Ramp, and of course A/C are available in our Country Store built in the late 1800s. We accept Cash, Card, PayPal, and will be evaluating additional payment applications. Our stocked pond has fishing poles and worms available for catch and release fishing. Our petting Zoo is called 'Two by Two' is free but we do have a bucket to help support their eating habits. It has Miniature Donkeys, Alpacas, Goats, Chickens, and Ducks. We are a Harvest Host site and provide single night, self-contained RV camping for Harvest Host members. Next door to the farm is a White Tailed deer farm and the Barn-Dominion is a nice 900 square foot Cypress walled studio available via Airbnb.

Our 2400 Square foot Pole Barn located by the pond can be used for picnicking, corn hole, pickle ball, and events such as Dances, Family Reunions, Company Parties, Cook Outs, and more at reasonable rates. The outdoor movie theatre has a 30 foot screen and a stage for performers just bring your own chair or blanket. A large grass area can be used for Volleyball, Kickball, and other sports activities. Nearby activities include Kayaking down the North Prong of Black Creek, Baldwin Bike Trail, Equestrian Center which has paved bike trails, and Jennings Forrest which has many hiking trails and beautiful tributaries of Black Creek spanning 20,000 acres.





The Loomis Brother's Circus comes to Clay County Fairgrounds on September 29, 2023. Experience a show that features animals, acrobats, motorcycle daredevils and plenty of clowns too. Don't miss Rolla Bolla showing off their balancing skills with props, chairs and more. Unicycle acrobats, the Globe of Death featuring motorcycling stunts and the Loomis Bros. Band round out the entertaining circus. Amazing Grace Family Farms comes alive on Fridays and Saturdays in October with their annual fall festival and corn maze. Returning to the vast property, between Middleburg and Keystone Heights on SR 21, south of Highway 16, the farm makes the perfect spot for photos while little ones enjoy outdoor activities. Known to be one of Clay County's most popular Fall attractions, the entire family can take advantage of fun on this family-owned farm.

St. Michael's Soldiers presents **Rock the Box 3**, a free night of music for our heroes on October 7 at the Thrasher-Horne Center. This year's show is sure to be another hit with Aaron Lewis scheduled as the headline artist. A maximum of 2 free tickets are available for troops and veterans, hospital/ front line workers, first responders, teachers and linemen. Must submit ticket request and receive tickets for entry. Free tickets will not be available at the show.

The **Fall Harvest Festival** takes place on October 7 at the Clay County Fairgrounds. With free admission, families and visitors can enjoy local vendors, great eats from local food trucks and live music.

The Town of Penney Farms welcomes visitors to take a trip to bygone days at the **Old-Fashioned Farm Day** on October 13, 2023. Enjoy exhibits of antique farm equipment, tools, early crafts along with antique and classic cars on display.

Grab a bite to eat at local food trucks, play carnival games with prizes all in the shade of our beautiful Live Oak trees, Magnolia trees and Crepe Myrtles.

The Bulls, Barrels & BBQ event returns to the Clay County Fairgrounds on October 14th and 15th. Experience a night of country fun with live music, professional bull riders and highspeed barrel racers from the Off R Rocker and the Elite Bull riders Association.

Enjoy nights along the riverfront at Food Truck Friday at Spring Park in Green Cove Springs featuring live music and local eats from around Northeast Florida. Held the second Friday of each month March to November from 5 p.m. to 9:30 p.m., bring a blanket or a lawn chair and enjoy the views overlooking the St. Johns River.

Orange Park's 41st Annual Fall Festival takes place October 21-22 at the Orange Park Town Hall. What started with twelve vendors and a few musicians has blossomed into a festival featuring over 200 vendors and two stages packed with live music. Festival-goers can shop for unique gifts,

handmade guilts, locally made pottery and more. Food vendors include a variety of items including barbecue to fresh baked goods, seafood and local honey. In the Kids Zone, little ones can enjoy face painting, inflatables and games. Admission and parking are free! This event is ranked as a Top 20 event by the Southeast Tourism Society.

At the Orange Park Community Theatre, make plans to see the mystery Mouse Trap by Agatha Christie October 6-22, 2023. And stay tuned for an exciting lineup in 2024 with A Gentlemen's Guide to Love & Murder and also Bugsy Malone: The Musical.

For a fun night at the theater, don't miss The Island Theater's lineup of shows taking place this Fall/Winter with favorites like Disney's Newsies - The Broadway Musical from October 6-15, 2023 and the spooky Night of the Living Dead October 20-29 – perfect for Halloween. Experience a bit of culture at the **Puerto Rican Expo** on November 18 at the Clay County Fairgrounds. Explore outdoor children's educational and interactive activities, folkloric dances, live entertainment and a food court filled with Latin American flavors. This year's event will focus on the history and flavors of coffee, cocoa and chocolate!

The **River City Hunter Jumper Association** welcomes visitors to one of their three events this fall/winter at the Clay County Fairgrounds. Choose from September 15-17, October 20-22 or November 17-19 to see competitors and their horses in action. From competitive events to showing the horses and a Halloween Horse show in October, these are great events for horse lovers.

This fall, take in a show at the **Spotlight Events Center** in Fleming Island with live performances that include dinner! September 28 through October 14 don't miss seeing *Everything's Coming Up Carol: A Tribute Show* where The Carol Burnett Show comes to life on stage. The Center's Spotlight Kids take the stage October 14-21 for the *Spotlight Kids: Skele-Tones Halloween Spectacular.* Experience magic and mystery at the *Halloween Monster Bash* October 19 through October 28. Then, the classic *Willy Wonka: The Musical* is performed by the Spotlight Kids November 24 through December 23. For the holiday season *Irving Berlin's Holiday Inn: The Broadway Musical* takes center stage November 24 through December 30. Enjoy a night out with live music at the **Thrasher-Horne Center** on the campus of St. Johns River State College. Country stars Aaron Tippin, Sammy Kershaw and Collin Raye team up for their Roots & Boots tour on September 15, then the Plain White T's come to Clay County on September 23. With over 30 million records sold, Billy Ocean takes the stage on October 25. Then, on November 3 the band Warrant makes their way to Orange Park. Now in their fifth decade, Three Dog Night brings their legendary hits to town on December 1.

Vintage Market Days returns to the Clay County Fairgrounds on December 1-3 with vintage-inspired merchandise, repurposed finds, jewelry, clothing and more available for purchase. This three-day, juried event prides itself on vendors offering a variety of goods of high quality and originality. Known as an indoor/outdoor market, Vintage Market Days is a popular event with both locals and visitors offering shopping that can't be found anywhere else.

There's plenty of excitement taking place at the Clay County Fairgrounds this fall with the return of the **Cowboy Mounted Shooting competition** taking place December 29-31. Known to be one of the fastest growing and most exciting equestrian sports in America, cowboy mounted shooting combines elements of a Wild West Show exhibition shooting along with the skills of barrel racing, pole bending and reigning while using two .45 caliber single action revolvers loaded with black powder blanks.

Escape The Cold-Winter Activities

Winter weather got you down? Wanting to spend more time outdoors, but the chilly temperatures are keeping you inside? Plan yourself a visit to Clay County, Florida and soak up some Florida sunshine as you breathe in the outdoors.

Here's a look at some popular activities to experience this winter during your time in Clay County -

Let's Play Golf!

Interested in playing golf this winter? Choose from one of Clay County's four, pristine golf courses. In Green Cove Springs, test your skills at the <u>Magnolia Point Golf Club</u> among the pine and magnolia trees. Set within a 1,000-acre community, wildlife is frequently seen on the course, making it a unique playing field for golfers. The <u>Fleming Island Golf</u> <u>Course</u> comes in at 6,700 yards with a par of 71. Surrounded by water and carefully-place sand bunkers, the front nine challenges golfers to play their best game while the back nine features a quiet course among the trees and wildlife.

Unique to Fleming Island Golf Club is the **Top of the Tee** – home to ten covered hitting bays equipped with Toptracer Technology. Each bay has its own seating area, paired with a nearby bar and televisions making this venue perfect for groups. Golfers can choose from different games including closest to the pin, longest drive competitions, points games and more. The lighted driving range also allows for players to practice even after the sun goes down.

In Clay County's Oakleaf neighborhood, <u>Eagle Landing Golf</u> <u>Course</u> features a 7,037-yard, par 72 course surrounded with Southern pine and palmetto trees. With six tees, ranging from juniors to championship, this course progresses in difficulty as the game finds its way the 18th green.

Best known for their island practice green, the <u>Eagle</u> <u>Harbor Golf Course</u> in Fleming Island features an 18-hole course surrounding the Eagle Harbor community of homes. Designed by award-winning course architect Clyde B. Johnston, golfers can enjoy rolling Bermuda grass fairways with plenty of water hazards to make the course a bit more challenging.

Go for a Bike Ride

Whether you are into biking nature trails, the open road or racing against fellow competitors, Clay County offers a variety of options for those interested in exploring the area on two wheels in the wintertime.

One of Clay County's most popular biking spots is the <u>Black</u> <u>Creek Park and Trail</u>. Adjacent to Highway 17, this 8-mile paved path connects bikers and walkers to points between Orange Park, Fleming Island and Green Cove Springs. Black Creek Park serves as a starting/ending location with parking, a covered pavilion and restrooms. The park also serves as the starting point for the mountain bike course that runs two miles through the park. Existing trailheads are at Black Creek Park, <u>Thunderbolt Park</u> and <u>Camp Chowenwaw County Park</u>.

In Keystone Heights, cyclists can join in on the <u>Palatka-to-Lake-Butler State Bike Trail</u>. This 47-mile trail connects west of U.S. 17 in Palatka to State Road 238 in Lake Butler, as it runs along the former Norfolk-Southern Railroad right-of-way through Putnam, Clay, Bradford, and Union counties. This cycling path was deemed part of the Florida Greenways and Trails System in 2007 and purchased with Preservation 2000 funds through the Florida Greenways and Trails Acquisition Program.

Look for Manatees

Manatees, also known as sea cows for their grazing habits, can often be tough to find in their natural habitats. Often found in salt, brackish and fresh water, manatees are slowmoving mammals that spend their days eating and sleeping.

Manatees cannot tolerate cold water temperatures for extended periods of time. They look for warmer waters when the water temperatures drop below 68 degrees Fahrenheit. Between November and March, manatees tend to migrate toward natural springs and waters near power plant discharge canals – both known to be places with warm water temperatures.

In Clay County, areas known for manatee sightings include the vegetation along Black Creek, Doctors Lake near private docks, Governor's Creek in Green Cove Springs and the mighty St. Johns River.

So, pack your warm weather clothes and get ready to visit Clay County – home to beautiful golf courses, hiking and biking trails, peaceful waterways, and small towns. We invite you to experience a side of Clay County that allows you to enjoy the Florida sunshine this winter.



Spend time outdoors in Clay County exploring the 35 miles of trails throughout a variety of local and state parks, conservation areas and Florida trailways. As home to three sites along the Great Florida Birding and Wildlife Trail, there's no shortage of wildlife sightings right here in Clay County.

Here's a look at where you can sleep under the stars and explore the trails of Clay County -

Black Creek Park and Trail

As home to one of Clay County's most popular trails, <u>Black</u> <u>Creek Park and Trail</u> covers just over 71 acres with a variety of ecosystems including pine flatwoods and wetlands. The eightmile paved pedestrian and bicycle trail can be accessed from the parking lot and runs north along U.S. Highway 17. The park's Black Creek Mountain Bike Trail system features three different trails of differing degrees each with their own elevation changes, tree roots and turns. Each trail begins and ends at the parking lot and are completely shaded, perfect for even the novice bikers. The Creek View trail is 2.5 miles long and has breathtaking views of Black Creek. The 9 Lives trail and Palmetto's Revenge Trail both stretch for about one mile. Each of the trails were designed and maintained by the Southern Off-Road Bicycle Association in Jacksonville (SORBA).

Camp Chowenwaw

Dating back to 1933, Green Cove Springs' <u>Camp Chowenwaw</u> <u>County Park</u> was once Florida's first Girl Scout Camp. Today, the public park offers 150 acres, a swimming pool and numerous trails for exploring and pristine conditions for overnight camping. From one of the many onsite cabins to a night in one of the eight treehouses, families can sleep under the stars at this historic campground.

Go for a hike on the Jungle Trail and make your way to the observation deck overlooking Black Creek. Explore the new Pawpaw Nature Center to learn about the animals and habitats that call Clay County home. At the nearby pollinator garden, visitors can learn how to attract and support butterflies and other pollinators at home.

Mike Roess Gold Head State Park

Known as one of Florida's First State Parks, <u>Mike Roess Gold</u> <u>Head Branch State Park</u> in Keystone Heights is home to 2,000 acres with 5.44 miles of trails along the Florida National Scenic Trail.

Go fishing or go for a swim in Little Lake Johnson. If you'd like to explore the area by water, canoe rentals are available. As a full-facility campground with 73 camp sites, overnight accommodations are available for RVs, tents and historic cabin rentals.

Jennings State Forest

At nearly 24,000 acres, Jennings State Forest, located just

outside of the Middleburg and Oakleaf neighborhoods, is home to 15 different biological communities including sandhill, slope forest, flatwoods, seepage slope, dome swamp, blackwater stream and seepage stream.

The forest is open daily during daylight hours for visitors interested in hiking, biking, canoeing and horseback riding throughout the area. There are three hiking trails ranging from 1.7 miles to 5-mile loops taking visitors along waterways and primitive areas in the forest. Overnight camping and primitive campsites are available at the Hammock Campground.

Bayard Conservation Area

Located just south of Green Cove Springs, the <u>Bayard</u> <u>Conservation Area</u> features 10,371 acres of conservation land with seven miles of beautiful views along the St. Johns River. A variety of wildlife calls the area home including gopher tortoise, bald eagle, little blue heron, deer and turkey. Hikers can enjoy 15 miles of trails inside the John P. Hall Nature Preserve located within the conservation area. Climb the observation tower for wildlife viewing and views of the nearby St. Johns River. Two campsites within the preserve are available for overnight stays. Along with exploring the hiking trails, choose from equestrian trails, bank fishing, bird watching and primitive launch sites for canoes and kayaking.

Get ready to create your own camping and hiking adventures when you visit Clay County. Explore the natural wonders that call the area home and take advantage of the outdoor opportunities during your stay. 



Unique Places in Clay County

There's no shortage of unique people and places when it comes to life in Clay County. From a space shuttle fuel tank (yes, really!), a fresh spring that's actually a community pool and more – there's plenty to explore in Northeast Florida.

Let's take a look at some of the more unique places you can discover during your visit. What's your favorite, unique place to explore in Clay County?

Club Continental – A Luxurious Playground

Located in Orange Park, the <u>Club Continental</u> was once known as the Palmolive Estate (yes, like the soap). In the 1880's, B.J. Johnson, owner of the Palmolive Soap Company, was looking to escape the harsh winters of Wisconsin and brought his family to Orange Park for the winter months.

Their first home, known today as The Winterbourne, now hosts weddings and private events. The family built then built a home next door and named it Mira Rio, now known as today's Club Continental. The home was host to many, riverfront parties throughout the 1920's ranging from social events, equestrian meets, yacht parties and more. In 1966, Mira Rio became a private, member club and renamed to <u>Club Continental</u>. The property is expanded to include seven tennis courts, three swimming pools, and twenty-two guest rooms.

Home to a Space Shuttle Fuel Tank

A replica of a space shuttle fuel tank is probably the last thing you'd expect to see along the St. Johns River in Clay County, but it's true! Located at the Reynolds Industrial Park, the fuel tank is actually a replica fuel tank that was used for structure and stress testing between 1977 and 1980 at NASA's Marshall Space Flight Center in Huntsville, Alabama.

Upon the closure of the space shuttle program, NASA moved the replica fuel tank to the Kennedy Space Center in Florida and began selling items in 2013 with the nowclosed Wings of Dreams Aviation Museum in nearby Starke purchasing this relic. When the business realized the added costs of transporting the fuel tank from Reynolds Park to its museum, approximately 50 miles away, they parked the item at its current location in 2013. The nearby <u>Military Museum</u> <u>of North Florida</u> now owns the relic and is in early talks to move the item to museum property soon.

An interesting and surprising piece of NASA and space shuttle history located in Clay County, the fuel tank is accessible to visitors interested in seeing it up close. It certainly makes for an interesting story – and pictures too.

Enjoy Swimming in Spring Water in Green Cove Springs While it may appear that the community pool located at <u>Spring Park</u> in Downtown Green Cove Springs, is just 'another pool', however that couldn't be farther from the truth.

The 135,000-gallon pool is actually spring-fed with the spring water flowing into the west side of the municipal swimming pool and exiting to continue the trek to the nearby St. John's River. The water surges up from below at a rate of 1,346 gallons per minute and at a constant temperature of 77 degrees.

Surrounding the poll and spring area is a new, two-story building a new two-story pavilion with new bathrooms and a concession area on the first floor. A splash pad, new walkways and wheelchair accessible ramps, and new railing along with signage can be found around the spring. Since its completion in 2017, the pool has become the City's top attraction for visitors—serving as a centerpiece for City and City-sponsored events.

Penney Farms – Unique Settlers and History

In 1922, as owner of the Golden Rule Stores around the country, now known as JC Penney, James Cash Penney purchased 120,000 acres of unincorporated land with the hopes of creating experimental farming community and a utopian village. He brought homesteaders from all walks of life and provided them with 40 acres of land per family and offered training and equipment to farm on their own. After being successful for two years, they would own the land.

In addition to purchasing the land, J.C. Penney also founded the Memorial Home for ministers and missionaries with low incomes to retire there and prosper. Memorial Home was a tribute to his minister father, wherein a community formed around itself with the incoming settlers. In 1927, the unincorporated Long Branch City was renamed Penney Farms and chartered in honor of James Cash Penney.

Today, the town of Penney Farms is home to a population of nearly 900, of which over 500 are residents of Penney Retirement Community. The town's retirement community is unique in that it is one of the oldest in the country to feature continuing care from independent homes and apartments to nursing care for differing needs. The community prides itself on being the 'most giving zip code' in America with their charitable contributions to the community.

UNITED METHODIST CHURCH (Circa 1847) 3925 Main Street

This building is one of the oldest Methodist churches in continuous use in Florida. It is a frame vernacular Church built of Hand-wrought lumber and nails. Mr. George Branning later donated the bell which was forged in New York and shipped by steamboat. One early use of the bell was to toll the death of his son, Robert Branning, who died in 1861 at 20 years of age.

THE HOUSES OF HISTORIC MIDDLEBURG









THE BARDIN HOME (Circa 1888) 3881 Main Street

This is Middleburg's only example of Italian architec ture. This style is more common in other areas of the country that in the South. There is a central cupola which is a small structure built on to the house. It is often used as a lookout and for air supple ventilation. Mr. Henry Bardin's house has two wide porches across the front of the hoe. It also has Victorian style gingerbread trim. The Bardins used to have square dances there many Saturday nights.

THE STEWART HOME

(Circa 1890-1911) 3895 Main Stree This is Middleburg's only example of center gable frame vernacular architecture. It is a white two-story home with a porch. It has a front facing gable wall dormer window. The home was built by George Chalker. As Mr. Chalker had a home on wharf Street, he rented this house to Mr. and Mrs. G.P, Stewart. The Stewarts moved from the Gin House Landing area where they had a turpentine mill.

THE GEORGE **CHALKER HOME**

(Circa Late 1800's) 2160 Wharf Street This white two-story home sits on a large area of land. It is Colonial Revival architecture which features a flat roofed porch with a railing above which is supported by square columns. There is a dormer window on the roof on the front of the house. A vine-covered retaining wall fronts the home on Wharf Street. The Chalker family was related to many families in Middleburg. It is presently under-going renovation and restoration.

THE GEORGE **HASKELL HOME**

(Circa Late 1800's) 3894 Main Street This frame vernacular home was built by Mr. Haskell as a replica of his home in Salem Mass. He was stationed with the Union troops during the Civil War in the area. He was attached to the Paymaster Corps. He later acquired 500 acres of land. The house is three stories and has been remodeled and kept in good condition. It is white with a decorative eagle on it.

THE BARTHLOW HOME (Circa 1800's) 3884 Main Street

This is a frame vernacular home, which is a typical wood frame home of the period. It is a small home with a tin roof and green metal awnings over the porch. Homes during this period were built with fireplaces for heat as is this one This home has a metal fence. Some of the other homes have wooden, brick, metal or stone fences in front of their homes. Some do not have fences. This home remains in the Barthlow family to this day.

LONG HOUSE (Circa 1890) 3858 Main Street

This home was purchased by Edward Long for his parents in 1896. It was an example of the open side gamble frame vernacular style. This building features drop siding exterior wall fabric and an exterior field stone chimney stack.





OLD MASONIC LODGE

(Circa Late 1800-1889) 3893 Main Street This building was moved to its present site from where the present Masonic Lodge is now. It is often called "the old lodge," It has an open side gable frame vernacular building built in the federal-period style. It has a one bay gable roof entrance porch on the east side. This yellow painted two-story building is balanced or symmetrical in appearance. It is beside the Clark-Chalker house.

THE FROSARD BUDINGTON HOME (Circa 1910) 3916 Main Street

This is Historic Middleburg's only example of Queen Anne architecture. It is unusual in that it is a single story with a rounded corner on the veranda porch. The rounded columns are called ionic. The interesting shape of the left-hand gable window when facing the front of the house is called Palladian. In 1927, Mr. and Mrs. F. Budington gave a deed to the Middleburg United Methodist Church which later added the Budington Educational Building. This home is now owned by Mrs. Pat Mueller.

THE BUDINGTON HOME

(Circa Late 1800's) Originally at 3913 Main Street

This is a white two-story house with a wide L-shaped porch which extends out to an area which can be used now as a carport. The shutters on this home are functional. This frame vernacular home is thought to have been moved to its present sit by rolling it on logs from across the street where the F. Budington home is now. This home is simpler in appearance on the outside than the Frosard Budington house across the street. This house has been relocated to the Main Street Park.

DR. G.E. ADAMS & **DR. STONE HOME**

(Circa Early 1900's) 2145 Wharf Street This building is a small frame vernacular home. It has decorative wooden trim on it. There is wooden "gingerbread" trim at the top of the porch columns. The porch with railing is on the left side of the house when facing the front. This building served as a Doctor's office and home in 1914. Later. the house became a private residence.

THE CLARK-CHALKER HOUSE

(Circa 1835) 3891 Main Street This is the oldest building in Middleburg. It is a white two-story columned house with a white picket fence. This open side gable frame vernacular home was built for Capt. Matthew Clark and his staff. They were with the U.S. 2nd Dragoons stationed at Ft Heilman. During the Second Seminole Indian war, the house was headquarters for General Winfield Scott. Martha Ann Chalker later occupied the house for 82 years until her death in 1936.

THE HADDEN HOME

(Circa 1912) 3887 Main Street This is a colonial revival home with a balanced front called a symmetrical façade. This is a two-story home with round columns. It has a tin roof like several of the historic homes in the historic district. An interesting aspect of this home is that the decoration above the front door was originally made from an old bed headboard. This is called a decorative entrance Pediment

Green Cove Springs Historic Walking Tour

Spring Park - The Spring tapers down with clear visibility to a depth of 31 feet up from which flows 78 degree mineral water filling the pool at 1300 gallons per minute for chemical free swimming in the summer. In the late 1800's many came to partake of the medicinal waters and some even stayed. Today the park includes the pool, the spring, playground, cooking pavilion, numerous gazebos, picnic tables, a stream, fishing pier and boat slips with water and electricity on the St. Johns River.

2 215 Spring Street - City Hall is seen west of the park. It was completed in 2004 on the site of the Qui Si Sana Hotel which faced the spring (c. 1907 meaning "Here is Health"). The architectural features of City Hall have similarities of the Qui Si Sana. Prior to the Qui Si Sana, the same site was occupied by the Clarendon Hotel (1870 – 1900). Guests of the Clarendon had exclusive use of the spring.

3 103 S. Magnolia Avenue – This frame vernacular style is characteristic of one of the most popular building styles in this region during the late 1800's. This building was used as a cottage for the Clarendon Hotel as well as the residence of Dr. Joseph Applegate who prescribed and dispensed the "medicinal" spring water to his wealthy northern clientele. It is in current use as the River Park Inn Bed and Breakfast.

4 219 Spring Street – Built in 1887, this home was, for many years, in the family of Judge Rivers. Notice the design pressed into the metal roof and the wonderful wrap around porch.

5 Footbridge – Across Spring Run connecting the North and South sides of the park, this bridge was built in 1988 by a Hungarian immigrant and Vietnam War Army veteran, Antal Molnar and his son Antal Jr. Note the replica of the old city seal in the center of the intricate iron work.

⁶ Spring Run is the stream from the outflow of the springfed chemical-free community pool. "Friends of the Park" were responsible for the large riverfront gazebo built in 1984 and still used regularly today for weddings and other events. Cross the bridge and take the sidewalk along St Johns Avenue.

14 North St. Johns Avenue – Built circa 1897 and known as the home of Captain C. E. Garner of the Independent Line Steamers that operated the May Garner riverboat between here and Jacksonville in the early 1900's, this home has been lovingly restored in the Italian Renaissance style by its current owners.

⁸ 15 N. St. Johns Avenue – the winter residence of the Carl Schultz family of NY; it was later known as the Hallock Hotel.

218 Palmer Street - The original home of Dustin Page is still maintained as a private residence.

115 St. Johns – Built in the Italian Renaissance style as his family's first residence, W. M. Hoyt, a Chicago grocery chain magnate was one of many wealthy northerners who invested in real estate in Green Cove Springs in the late 19th century. It later became known as the Riverview Hotel.

200 N. St. Johns – Having the means to do so, W. M. Hoyt later built this house designed by architect, Mellon Greeley, in 1917 for his family in the Mediterranean Revival style with features such as the stucco exterior and tile roof. The building has now been converted to condominiums.

400 St. Johns Avenue – St. Mary's Episcopal Church, built in 1979, continues to serve an active parish today. It is built in Carpenter Gothic Style. Note the small doors beneath each window. They are more often used for ventilation but they would provide escape in case of fire. On the same property notice the Fellowship Hall. It was originally one of 5 army chapels at Camp Blanding built in the early 1940's and later relocated to this site for the church.

405 St. Johns Avenue – The rectory for St. Mary's Episcopal Church, circa 1906, was erected with funds from the Morton Fox Memorial Fund, according to the historical marker on the left eve of the house.

208 Park Street – One of three still existing homes in town originally built for members of the Borden family of condensed milk fame.

15 502 North Magnolia Avenue – Called "Villa Cottage", this home was built in 1880 by John C. Borden, son of the inventor of condensed milk. The tower on the right was used for judging the horse races which occurred on Magnolia Avenue. It was later used as the first home of the Women's Club better known as the Village Improvement Association (VIA).

300 Gum Street – First Presbyterian Church, circa 1892, is a detailed carpenter gothic style church. Designs on the hand forged hinges as well as the shapes and colors of the windows have special meanings. The Friendship Hall was completed as an addition in 1995.

17 303 North Magnolia Avenue – Circa 1884, Queen Anne style, rumors have circulated for many years about the ghosts in residence!

18 312 Center Street – This beautifully restored 1890's residence was most recently an art studio.

19 326 Walnut Street – Green Cove Springs got its own Art Deco style theater in the mid 1930's. The owner in 1936, R. C. Wilson, relocated the business from 420 Walnut Street where it was known as the Palace Opera House and Motion Picture Show. In 1939 a license permit was issued for the Clay Theater to Frank Bryant. Today it is the Clay Theatre, An Event Venue.

400 Block of Walnut Street - Walnut Street developed early as the main street for business in town because it led to the town's general landing at the east end where the fishing pier is now located. In 1882 there was a barbershop, a cobbler, several grocery stores, 2 churches, a bakery, a photography shop and several hotels on Walnut Street. 17 North Palmetto Avenue – Built in 1915, this is the most significant social building in Green Cove Springs. This land was donated to the VIA for the building in 1885 by Penelope Borden, of condensed milk fame. It is Spanish Colonial Revival style, designed by architect Mellon Greeley. A Florida Heritage Site, it still serves the community as the Village Improvement Association.

22 509 Walnut Street - is preserved as the home-place of Ma and Pa Gustafson of Gustafson Milk fame.

23 604 Walnut Street – (Council on Aging) Grady Smith bought the Coca Cola Operation from E. E. Geiger and moved it to this location which was built in 1946. At the time of the plant closure in 1971, 1,160 cases of the 6.5 ounce bottles were produced in an 8 hour day compared to 12,000 cans of canned coke per hour in the Jacksonville plant. Since the 1970's the building has a center for Clay County seniors.

615 Walnut Street – First Baptist Church was constituted in 1889 and this church was constructed 1916. The stainedglass windows were imported from Germany prior to WWI.

25 700 Walnut Street. Built in 1890, this residence is the best example of the Queen Anne style in town. Note the intricate stick and spindle work on the porches and gable ends.

26 707 Walnut Street – Saved from demolition in 2005 when the county purchased the property next to the Council on Aging for parking, this building, circa 1890, was moved diagonally across the street. It was formerly the home of Senator Slater Smith.


27 715 Walnut Street – Originally a residence, this 1909 frame vernacular has been restored and used over the years for a number of commercial purposes.

28 23 S. Green Street & Walnut – Now home to the Clay County School Board, the H. D. Long Building was a WPA Project in 1937 designed by architect, Roy A. Benjamin. It served as Clay High School for many years.

29 915 Walnut Street – The Historic Triangle Complex includes the restored Italian Renaissance style courthouse, circa 1890, which has been restored for the use of Family and Teen Court. The Annex on the left houses the Clay County Historical Museum. The museum also houses a fine railroad collection, train station and caboose. On the north end of the triangle is the 1894 Jail. The jailer's quarters have been restored to house the Clay County Archives and Sheriff's Museum.

627 Spring Street Circa - Typical construction from the late 1800's this home has a regular rectangular floor plan and a balloon frame structural system with two stories and a steep roof to accommodate a sizeable attic. Note the porches here. Porches were a common feature and decoration often included ornamental woodwork, brackets, patterned shingles, turned porch columns and exposed rafter ends under the eaves. The original balcony porch here has interesting, upturned detail on the upper rail.

501 Spring Street - Thought to have been built about 1845, the architecture is Frame Vernacular with elements of 2nd Empire with mansard roof and shingle siding. Known for years as the Jensen house where a local eye doctor practiced his craft, the building was renovated in 1993 for commercial use as a funeral home. The chapel was added in 1997.



The Town of Orange Park was founded in 1877 by the Florida Winter Home and Improvement Company. The property was subdivided into building lots and small farm tracts, and the present street system was laid out which included Kingsley Avenue, River Road and Plainfield Avenue. 
Walking Tour of Historical Homes

Keystone Heights was established in 1923 by the Lawrence Developing Company. Its owner, J. J. Lawrence, was from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The town was to be a vacation spot and health benefits from recreational opportunities, climate and clean water were highly emphasized in sales brochures. Key-stone Heights was on the Chatauqua RR Circuit. Citrus and pecan trees were also touted as good investment possibilities. Frank Walrath, a cousin, was head of sales for the development company.




The town was laid out in 1923 by an unrelated C. Ray Lawrence, also from Pennsylvania, who was a retired civil engineer. Streets and alleys as planned then, exist today.

Keystone's earliest homes, including that of J. J. Lawrence, are thought to be mail order catalogue homes. Some evidence exists in the form of handwritten labels and model numbers on framing. The homes in this tour are from the first building period (1921-1929). Initial development stopped when the stock market fell.
