The festival has been named one of Southeast Tourism Society's Top 20 Events in the Southeast for October four times. The festival also received two SunSational Awards from Florida Festival and Events Association and won Best of Clay for Best Community Event!

This year's festival will take place on October 19th and 20th from 10am – 5pm both days at Town Hall Park. Free parking and a shuttle is available at Moosehaven. Moosehaven is located at 1701 Park Ave. Limited handicap parking is available at the municipal lot located at the corner of Clinton Dr. and Smith Street.


Community Stage
