

Bradford County is a rural community located in Northeast Florida. Bradford was founded as New River County in 1858 but was renamed Bradford County in 1861. The county has a population of 27,000 people and covers 294 square miles. Bradford County is home to the City of Starke, City of Lawtey, City of Hampton and the Town of Brooker with Starke being the county seat.

Wildlife Management Areas

 Santa Fe Swamp Wildlife Management Area Southeast 11th Avenue, Starke, FL 32091 (Approximately 1/2 Mile off State Road 100)

The Santa Fe Swamp Wildlife Management Area (WMA) consist of 7,272 acres and is open for fishing, wildlife viewing, horseback riding, hiking, and bicycling throughout the year. Children under the age of 16 are required to wear a helmet when horseback riding on public lands. Hunting of white-tailed deer, feral hog, turkey, gray squirrel, and eastern cottontail rabbit is allowed in this WMA during specified seasons with primitive weapons only (bow and arrow and muzzleloader).

Raiford Wildlife Management Area
 Northwest County Road 125, Lawtey, FL 32058

Raiford WMA consists of 9,141 acres and is located along the New River in northwest Bradford County. The New River flows through the center of the WMA, and Olustee Creek (which branches off of the New River) flows through the eastern portion of the WMA. Much of the area is closed or in private ownership but the remaining portion of the area is open for hunting during specified seasons. Wild turkey, white-tailed deer, gray squirrel, eastern cottontail rabbit, gopher tortoise, raccoon, and red-tailed hawk are some of the wildlife species that can be found in the area.



he Bradford Extension provides research-based solutions to the community. We are dedicated to developing knowledge in agriculture, human and natural resources, and the life sciences and to making that knowledge accessible to sustain and enhance the quality of human life.

UF/IFAS Bradford County Extension Offers a Variety of Educational Programs for Citizens of All Ages

The UF/IFAS Bradford County Extension Office provides educational programming in a variety of areas including Agriculture, Natural Resources, Horticulture, Small Farms and 4-H Youth Development. From providing training to home gardeners to working with farmers on pasture management to embryology education in schools, these and many other programs are available to all citizens in Bradford County.

The Extension Office is a partnership between the United States Department of Agriculture, the University of Florida Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences, and the Bradford County Board of County Commissioners.

There are many success stories to tell about how Extension is making a difference in Bradford County. For example, in 2024:

- Thirty-four producers managing around 3,200 acres of pastureland in the county learned how to take a soil sample and properly identify pasture weeds for proper herbicide application rates resulting in money saved for their farming operations.
- After consulting with Extension staff, the City of Starke began an implementation of Florida Friendly Landscaping practices within the city limits. This results

not only in economic savings, but lower maintenance costs and greater aesthetics in the downtown area.

• The 4-H Youth Development Program served Bradford County youth through community clubs and school enrichment activities. Youth developed life skills through a variety of projects including livestock, public speaking, creative arts, shooting sports, gardening, and food & nutrition. Additionally, the 10th Annual Bradford 4-H Beef Bash Cattle Prospect Show took place at the beginning of 2025 hosting over 100 youth and 158 head of cattle. This learning experience for youth in preparation for the county fair was also a fundraising event for the 4-H program with 33 local sponsors and vendors supporting local youth.

Along with faculty and staff, there is a community of volunteers that support Extension in Bradford County. Master Gardeners and 4-H volunteers gave back 3,463 hours of service to the community equaling a value of \$109,465.



s Bradford County grows, its dining options expand as well.

In the past year, residents throughout the region have been able to expand their culinary experience with the addition of homegrown restaurants that feature Jamaican fare, Texas craft barbecue, a traditional homestyle menu and southern barbecue.

Let's sample all four. All you need to do is to bring your appetite.

Blueline Q

15070 U.S. Highway 301, Starke.

The first hint you get about their barbecue is their hours. The sign on the door says they open at 11 a.m. Wednesday through Saturday, and close when they run out of meat.

They don't serve leftovers from the previous day, so their pits are stocked with 200 pounds of brisket, 180 pounds of pork, 23 slabs of ribs, 21 pounds of jalapeno cheese sausage, 40 pounds of beef ribs and 40 pounds of beef tri-tip every morning at 3:30 a.m.

"The earliest we've sold out was 1:20 in the afternoon," said retired Lee County Sheriff's Office deputy and owner/pitmaster Matthew Davis

For those who aren't familiar with Starke, finding Blueline Q can be a chore. Just look for the welding store on the westside of U.S. Highway 301. The search is worth it.

Davis arrives at 3:30 a.m. every Wednesday through Saturday and his grills don't stop smoking. And he's insistent on one thing: he never serves leftovers.

"If we don't sell out, we send it home with our servers,"

Davis said. "We start fresh every day. We're always cooking. Our pits run the whole time; everything stays running between the offsets and rotisseries."

When Davis retired from the Lee County Sheriff's Office, he knew he couldn't transition to a leisurely routine in a rocking chair.

"I had to find something to do," he said. "I couldn't sit around. I set up a tent at North Florida Hospital and sold \$700 in tacos in one day. So I went back. A couple of weeks later, I did \$1,200. In the third week, I did \$1,400.

"So I bought my first food truck. It was a repo food truck. I put in new fryers, refrigerators, and everything and started the Texas barbecue that grew into

Blueline Q. I never would have thought we would have gotten to the size we are. We have truly been blessed. I can tell you that because I went from putting people in jail to being blessed."





Sky-D's Place

The last thing Skylar Davis wanted was a second restaurant. He already owned Dalton's Sports Bar and Grill in Middleburg that had exceeded all financial and customer expectations, so he

didn't necessarily have to take on a new project.

"The opportunity presented just itself," Davis said. "I've always said for years I would not ever deal with two restaurants because of the stress of

one is enough. But the opportunity was right and too good to pass up. We are just going to take it and run with it."

Davis admitted there was another underlying reason for turning the former Barnyard Diner into his family restaurant.

"Business skyrocketed and took off at Dalton's, which is great," Davis said. "It's been crazy busy, and I'm blessed to have that. But it got away from the slight town feel of being able to have fun and have random daily specials, and to keep the gears turning to keep it afloat.

"Something like a smaller location can be more of a creative kitchen for me, than just the same thing every single day, just pumping the food out to keep the masses happy. Hopefully,

we'll have lots of business there, but it won't be as crazy overwhelming as Dalton's is."

Davis said the menu at Sky-D's Place will feature the same chicken wings served at Dalton's—which was named after his brother—but he will also offer more homestyle offerings like chicken and dumplings, beef tips and rice, chicken and rice, country fried steak, fried catfish, fried venison and gizzards.

"I'm returning to the roots to reignite my creativity," he said. "People say I'm crazy because I've got Dalton's, Sky-D's, by podcast "Woodshed Confessions" and new baby girl, but the new restaurant will bring me back to my roots. It will let me be creative again."

Sky-D's Place's grand opening is planned for May.

g's BBQ

915 N. Temple Ave, Starke

Gary Park stood ankle-deep in soot-stained water on Jan. 9, 2024, a few hours after his G's Slow Smoked BBW was destroyed by a fast-moving fire in Orange Park.

The roof had holes, and portions of the back wall were charred. He knew it wasn't salvable, but his immediate concern was for the employees suddenly without a job.

One month later he bought the old Pizza Hut in Starke after receiving a telephone call from Wiggins Construction about the building. Park initially thought it was a chance to get his former employees back to work quicker than expected.

Renovations took longer than expected, but it was worth the wait. A busy restaurant lobby is a testament to G's BBQ's traditional award-winning southern barbecue.

"I didn't know what to expect, to be honest, but I was quite

surprised," Park said. "I tell you; they've been very receptive. The community has been great for us. It's turned out to be something quite surprising."

So good that Park is already expanding the restaurant to add grills for steaks. He's also pushing additional space at the rear of the restaurant to add walk-in coolers and smokers.

"We got great reviews on the food. It's taking a little bit to tweak it for the community," Park said. "It's our base recipes. It's just getting everybody, our new people, everybody working together in the kitchen and making certain the end product is consistent."

Park plans to rebuild Clay County on U.S. Highway 17 in Green Cove Springs. The plans call for a three-story building near Garber AutoMall, with the first two floors encompassing a barbecue restaurant and the third floor occupied by a cigar bar. Park said the ground-breaking will take place in late spring.

Caribbean Soul

200 Call St., Starke

Caribbean Soul offers items you won't find anywhere else in Bradford County, such as oxtails, jerk chicken, curry goat, peas and rice and curry chicken.

The one thing you won't find, however, are recipes.

"The recipes are all made by my grandmother," said manager Christopher Shackelford. "I mean, she and my granddad are the ones who cook the food. They have their style of how they make it. They have a certain way they make it. They're the only two that cook the food. The recipes have been her recipes that she's used all her life, she's been cooking since she was little, when she used to watch her parents cook. The meals just come from the heart.

"She doesn't write anything down. There is no recipe book. Every time she cooks, it's from her heart."

The grandmother, Vercille Hightower, has created a following. Caribbean Soul has continually received outstanding reviews from customers who wanted to venture outside their customary gastronomic boundaries.

"Everybody's been looking for a Caribbean restaurant," Hightower said. "They really say that they're glad the restaurant opened in that spot because they usually have to drive to Jacksonville to find that type of food."

Shackleford said the family knew it was risky to open a business, especially one that served a diverse menu. However, they knew that the same menu gave them an edge.

"It was a big leap of faith. We all invested," he said. "We went all into the restaurant once the opportunity was presented. We pushed forward and we revamped everything inside.

"We didn't know how it was going to go. But, you know,

business has been good. That has been steady. People have been coming in and spreading the word about the restaurant, so we continue to get business."

Just don't ask what's in a recipe. The only one who knows is Vercille, and she doesn't have it written down.



Bradford Sportsmen's Farm aims to be best, diverse shooting facility

ustomers have been having a blast – literally – at the Bradford Sportsmen's Farm since 1990.

The 183-acre shooting range in Graham continues to flourish for a basic reason, co-owner Danny Stefanelli said: "Everything we make, we put back into it."

The range's calendar is filled with local, state and national events. Still, there are plenty of opportunities for local shooters to hone their skills, attend classes with a National Sporting Clay Association certified shotgun instructor, or a National Rifle Association and U.S. Concealed Carry

Association instructor's conceal or safety course.

The facility is so highly regarded, it has been selected to host the state championships every four years.

"Guns have been popular for a long time, but it's really just taken off probably since COVID-19, because shooting was one of the outdoor sports during that time," Stefanelli said. "That's what people turned to. Golf picked up. It was just something that they could go outside and get away from each other."

Stefanelli's grandfather, AI, and Pat Welch were part of an investment group that purchased the land and created Bradford Sportsmen's Farm 35 years ago. AI Stefanelli and Welch eventually became the only owners, and when AI

died, Danny bought his half of the business.

Stefanelli also owns Bradford Gun on North Temple Avenue in Starke, but he said the shop will move to the Sportsmen's Farm.

While some shooters use the farm to sharpen their skills for protection, Stefanelli said the majority are there for entertainment.

"You've always got your crowd out there for their security," he said. "This is a very much a recreational sport, no different than golf. The only difference is you're shooting for a high score, not a low score."

Rails to Trails: Take a hike on the Palatka-Lake Butler State Trail

The paved, multi-use recreational Palatka-Lake Butler State Trail is situated in one of the state's most picturesque areas. This Northeast Florida region warmly welcomes the Florida State Park's trail for the enhanced quality of life and economic benefits it offers to many small towns and communities.

The trail corridor stretches nearly 47 miles from west of U.S. 17 in Palatka to State Road 238 in Lake Butler. It runs along the former Norfolk-Southern Railroad right-of-way through Putnam, Clay, Bradford and Union counties.

Purchased with Preservation 2000 funds through the Florida Greenways and Trails Acquisition Program, the Rails to Trails Conservancy played a key role in preserving the corridor for conversion to a rail-trail. It was designated as part of the Florida Greenways and Trails System in 2007, and the Florida Department of Transportation is constructing it in segments as funding becomes available.

Bradford County's portion runs 10.25 miles along the county's southern portion from Park of the Palms, through Theressa to Hampton to less than 2 miles south of State Road 100 to Lake Butler.

It includes the old railroad trestle crossing the New River on the Union/Bradford County line near Lake Butler.

This Northeast Florida region welcomes this state trail for the enhanced quality of life and economic benefits it offers to many small towns and communities.

The trail accommodates hiking, horseback riding, walking and running, water fountains, equestrian trails, and pets on leashes that are less than six feet.

Exact Spray Foam Solutions was started March 2022 with one spray foam rig and 2 employees. They purchased a second rig in May of 2024 and now have 7 employees. They have completed over 300 jobs with over half being in Bradford, Union & Clay Counties. While Florida does not currently require certification in order to own or operate a spray foam business, Clint has taken the initiative to become certified. While at the spray foam convention Vegas this past March, he passed the first two tests and became SPFA Certified. Unlike other certifying organizations, PCP Certifications are not awarded based on course completion. All candidates must demonstrate a level of knowledge, skills and abilities that only comes with validation through testing and experience. He will be taking

the final tests to become Certified SPF Insulation Master Installer and Certified SPF Insulation Project Manager at the February Convention in Daytona this year. Again while these are not current requirements, this will set the business apart from competitors in the SPF industry. While creating a sustainable business was the goal, Exact Spray Foam Solutions felt a great responsibility to give back to the local community that has been so supportive. In their short existence, they have sponsored several athletic school programs including the UCHS Softball, Volleyball, Baseball & Basketball teams and Babe Ruth baseball teams in 2023 & 2024. They have contributed to buying pigs and cows at both the Bradford County and the Union County Livestock Show & Sale. They also


