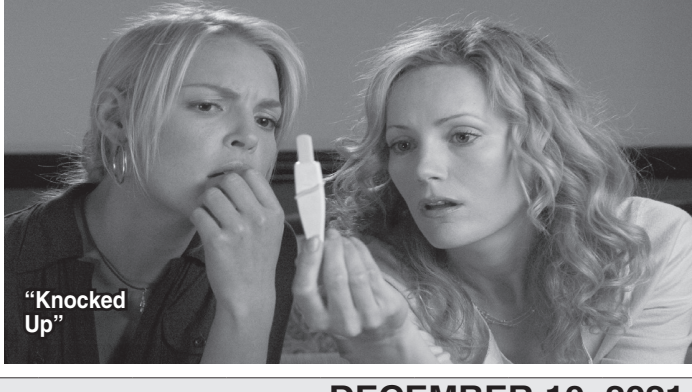

## Hansen takes first at Okobojoji Tournament

MILFORD — Estherville Lincoln Central 106-pounder Austin Hansen spent less than 2 1/2 minutes on the mat in winning his weight bracket at the Okobojoji/Hartley-Melvin-Sanborn Tournament last Saturday.

The sophomore pinned all three of his opponents while helping the Midgets tie for fifth place in the team standings. Hansen's first match was his longest, as he need 1 minute 38 seconds to pin Fulda/MCC's Teague Meyer. His semifinal match was his shortest of the day as Hansen pinned Central Lyon/George-Little Rock's Aston Van Beek in 19 seconds. In the final, Hansen pinned West Sioux's Reid Persinger in 25 seconds.

ELC's next highest finish came from freshman Wes Martin at 120 pounds as he finished third overall. Martin pinned Wes Hancock's Evan Boothroyd in 2:56 in the quarterfinal, but lost by fall to Dylan Jones of Okobojoji/HMS in the semifinal.
