LFD to bolster fire prevention efforts with FM Global grant

the board that the town had a commitment from a candidate to assume the role of Town Recorder and Treasurer. Bingham said that the individual already had the necessary certifications and experience in both roles. Bingham anticipated a start date in June.

The citizens comment period was more involved than normal.

One Depot Street resident clearly expressed her dissatisfaction with the impact from the new Little League ballpark in Depot Park.

She cited severe parking issues along the street on weekends including some attempts to park in her yard.

She also took the

board to task for the unavailability of the walking track for residents due to development in the park.

“Y’all have done a bad job,” she told the board. “That’s all I can say.”

The board allowed that there were parking issues that needed to be ironed out but that the new park had succeeded as much as could be hoped so far.

The walking track would hopefully be restored sometime next year.

The board also agreed to follow up on complaints regarding a retention pond on Sunnyside Drive.

The pond is not draining as it should and residents, who also spoke to the board last month, are concerned about issues with standing water and mosquitoes.

You may recall that -- in October of 2019-- I wrote a column denouncing the proliferation of confusing, dimly lit scenes in movies and TV shows.

Now it's time to unload on the audio aspect of the media.

Remember when Hollywood gave us effervescent heroes and scenery-chewing villains with crisp diction? Now many actors/characters are so low-pitched, understated and listless that their threats devolve into, "You'll get to watch your children die in front of you, but only if you don't drown in your Cap'n Crunch first. Please stop falling asleep in your cereal. I'm almost finished whispering my master pl--ZZZZZ."

I know these guttural thespians think smoking 20 cartons of Luckies a day was worth it because their voice is sexy enough to make great-grandmother start ovulating, but it's distracting for the rest of us.

Lack of energy isn't always the main factor in hard-to-understand dialogue. Some actors certainly have the pep to cram their mouths full of marbles before mumbling a soliloquy.

Unfortunately, foreign actors speaking exclusively in English is not a cure-all. Casting directors love actors who have an accent so overpowering you can hear the sound of your ears bleeding. It's like Chaucer's "Canterbury Tales" processed through Ye Olde Drive-Thru Speaker.

From Eddie Haskell to J.R. Ewing to today's scoundrels, I have always thought there were some characters who needed a "come to Jesus moment." Now I think there are characters who desperately need a "come to Henry Higgins" moment.

Let's do something about this situation.

I want you to get up right now and go to the window. Open it, and stick your head out, and yell: "I'm as mad as hell, and I'm not gonna...be able to be heard over the COMMERCIALS."

Sigh

“But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.” – Isaiah 40:31

The prophet Isaiah speaks of how the people of God will get their strength from the LORD God. It is the kind of strength that is compared to the strength of the wings of an eagle that flies high in the heavenly sky.

When a mother eagle wants to teach its little ones to fly from the nest high upon a cliff, hundreds of feet up in the air, it prods one of the little eaglets with its beak and noses it out of the nest. The weak eaglet

starts to free-fall and the mother eagle flies down and goes underneath it spreading her wings out and catches the little one. As soon as you think things are safe, the mother flies up high again and turns sideways. Yes, the eaglet falls again. This time the mother eagle circles around the eaglet as the eaglet start to flutter its wings as it falls like a rock. Again, the mother flies underneath the eaglet, catches it, goes back up, and turns sideways again having the eaglet take another dive downward. Amazingly, the mother eagle knows when the eaglet is tired from fluttering its wings as it tries to fly. So she scoops up her eaglet in mid air and returns it to the nest, only to have the nest stirred up again the next

day for another flying lesson. This continues until the day comes when the eaglet's wings have its strength to mount up on its own.

This image of “wings like eagles” is derived from the fact that the eagle rises up and effortlessly soars in the highest part of heaven's sky. The eagle is a lesson of strength, vigor, elevation, communion with the heavens, and a nearness to the heavenly throne of God. This strength coming from the LORD allows the believer to rise above this messed up world by exercising faith in God, and soar in the heavenly realm where all spiritual blessing in Christ Jesus our Lord and Savior dwells (Ephesians 1:3).

Rockets rally past Vikings to claim 7-AA title

CHAPEL HILL — Forrest head coach Andy Burkett knows it's tough beating a team three times in a single season.

But four or five? It's not just tough, it's downright unheard of.

That's just what his ball club did on Tuesday night, beating Community for a fifth time this season to claim the District 7-AA championship in a 9-8 come-from-behind victory.

"We were able to get them three times in the regular season and we caught them in the semifinals, they played us to an awesome ballgame," Burkett said.

"Playing them for a fifth time, I've always heard it's tough to beat a team three times, much less four and much less five. You have to give them (Community) a lot of credit. They faced some adversity and beat Cascade yesterday, they gave us absolutely everything we could handle."

The Rockets were hampered by errors throughout the game and at one point in the fourth inning, trailed 7-2, with the Vikings in cruise control.

Community was aggressive on the base paths early and scored the game's first run in the bottom of the first on a sac-fly RBI.

Forrest answered on a RBI single by Kason Fuller in the bottom of the inning.

Both teams plated a single run in the second inning, with the Rockets once again plating the equalizer on a RBI single to center field, tying the game at two.

After an evenly-played first two innings, Community went to work in the top of the third and built a 5-2 lead on two RBI singles and a RBI double.

But in the third, the Rockets were sat down in order by Community starter Mason Russell.

Things continued to spiral in favor of the Vikings in the fourth following a Rocket error in the infield and a hit batter after a sac-bunt, put runners on the corners with one out, prompting the Rockets to turn to Preston Gentry on the mound.

Forrest committed two more errors in the inning and Community plated two more runs, bumping the score to 7-2 after the fourth.

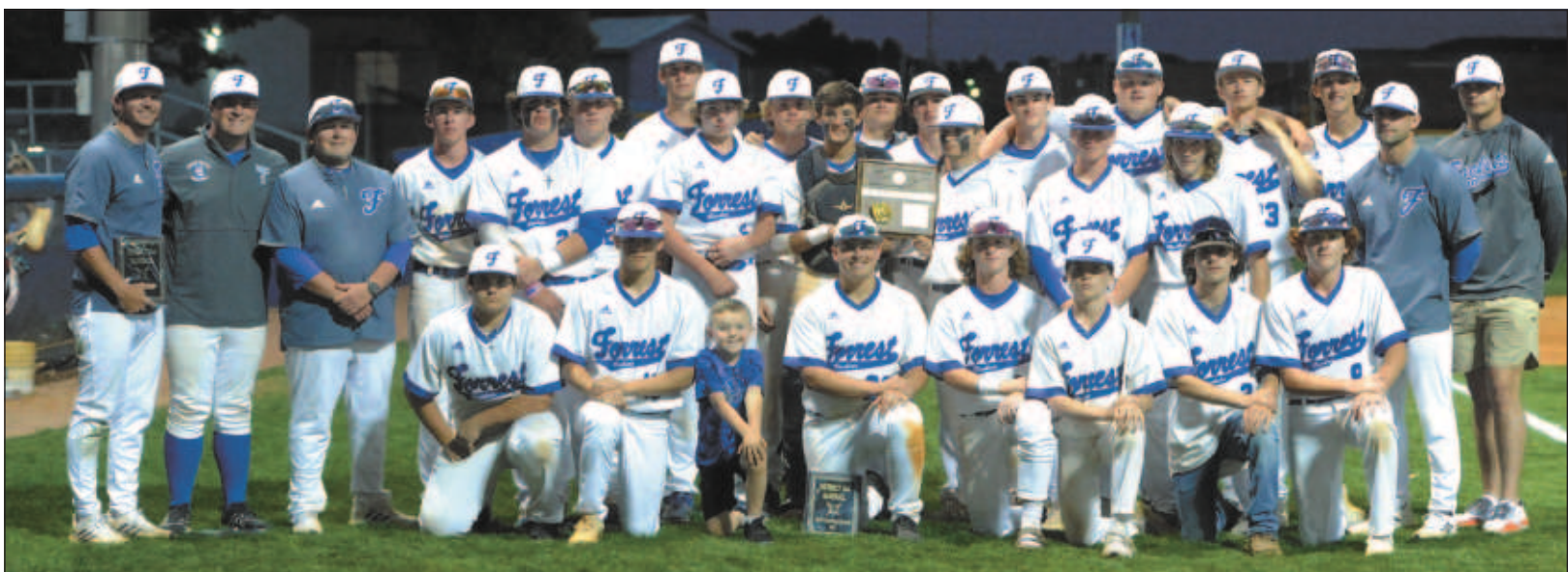
But Gentry delivered a near-flawless fifth inning after surrendering a leadoff single and was able to record three-straight outs to prevent another scoring inning for Community.

Riding off the moment, Camden Vaughn led off the bottom of the fifth with a double to deep left field and then scored on a Viking error.

The Rockets then got a huge momentum boost off the bat of Brennan Mealer, who slugged a two-run blast over the right field fence, pulling the Rockets within two.

Gentry followed the momentum off Mealer's shot and sat the Vikings down in order in the top of the sixth, and the Rockets picked up where they left off in the fifth.

Carter Walk was hit by a pitch to lead off the

inning and back-to-back bunt singles by Gentry and Andrew Timmons loaded the bases, with no outs, bringing Vaughn to the plate.

Vaughn was hit by a pitch, which scored the first run of the inning and Riley Durbin hit a sac-fly to right, that tied the game at seven apiece.

Fuller followed and ripped a ground ball

single to left, scoring another Rocket run.

Rather than pitch to Mealer, the Vikings called for an intentional walk, which loaded the bases.

A stellar at-bat by Braden Bowyer drew a bases-loaded walk, which scored a ninth Rocket run.

Hoping to slam the door shut on the Vikings, Mealer took over on the

mound, but struggled and loaded the bases after back-to-back walks and a hit batter.

Burkett then turned to Bowyer to close out the Vikings and despite giving up a run on a RBI fielder's choice, he did just that and the Rockets were able to claim the 7-AA tournament championship title.

"I think it's a testament to our guys. We're not out in any single ball game. We played an ugly ball game. We had five errors—we haven't

made five errors in a week all season," Burkett said.

Forrest was led by Vaughn and Fuller at the plate, both of whom connected on two hits.

Mealer's two-run blast was the biggest hit of the night for either team.

"Brennan is a table setter for us. He drives in a majority of our runs. He leads the team in RBIs and he's trying to figure out the best way to be able to put us in a position to win the ball

game. When that happened, it got us a shot in the arm and gave us the momentum that we needed to be able to get it done," Burkett said.

Ashton Grubbs got the start for the Rockets and went 3 1/3 innings. He gave up seven runs on seven hits, but only two of which were earned.

Gentry took over in the fourth and pitched 2 2/3 innings, giving up just one hit.

Bower slammed the door shut on the Vikings and pitched a flawless seventh.

Forrest also racked up the season awards, with Fuller, Moses, Bowyer and Vaughn each being named to the All-District team.

Mealer earned District 7-AA Pitcher of the Year honors, while Durbin was named District MVP.

Burkett was also named Coach of the Year.

Forrest has dominated the District 7-AA slate all season and the No. 1 Rockets continued that theme on Tuesday.

Now with the district title in hand, the Rockets get the rest of the week off before beginning Region 4-AA tournament next week.

"We'll get a chance to clean up some things defensively. Hats off to our pitching staff trying to figure out a way to get things done even when the going got tough," Burkett said.

"There's been a lot of baseball played in the last week and a half or so. We'll get back after it on Thursday, clean up some things defensively, try to figure out our pitching rotation for next week and be ready to give the other district all they can handle."

Forrest will host the No. 4 seed from the District 8-AA tournament on Monday evening.





Childress, in the circle for Cornersville, ran into trouble right off the bat, rather off the arm of Eagleville lead-off batter Brinili Bain, who was awarded first base, then following a sacrifice bunt by Sarah Thompson, Addi Linton hustled out a single, putting runners at the corners with one out.

Linton for Eagleville promptly stole second base and Rylee Warbritton drew a walk to load the bases then Bella Bain drew a bases loaded walk to put the Lady Eagles on the board, 1-0.

Childress helped her own cause by snaring a
