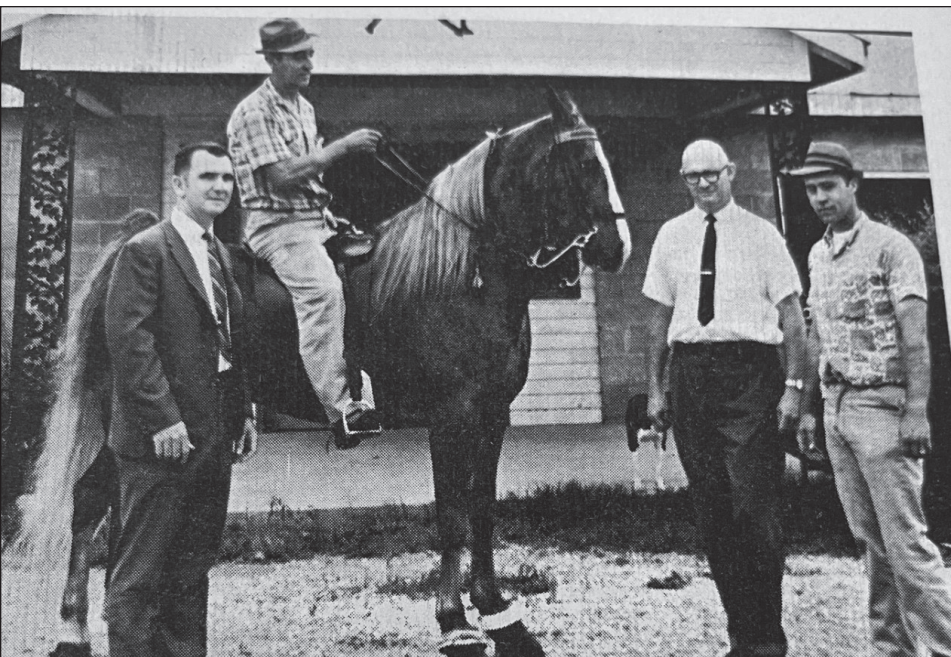


LOOKING BACK!
