

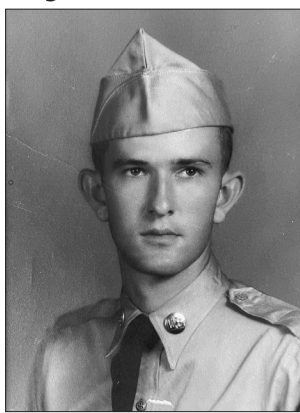

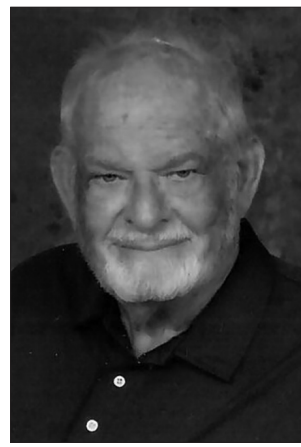
James William "J.W." Harper
