## Go Gold Saturday with MCCF

September is Childhood Cancer Awareness month and the Marshall County Cancer Foundation will host the Go Gold Festival at Rock Creek Park on Saturday, September 17. Admission is free. Beginning at 9 a.m. there will be a Miss Go Gold Pageant for Tiny Miss, Little Miss, Mini Miss, Jr. Miss, and Miss (ages 1 to 12). Following the pageant, The O'Donnells will provide entertainment. Their music brings a wide variety of musical influences from traditional country, gospel, blue grass, and early rock.

At 2:30 p.m., yellow rubber ducks will be dropped into Rock Creek for the Duck Race where the first, second, third, and last place will receive a cash prize. Ducks will be available for purchase till drop time. There will be a rock climbing wall, a sticky wall, and toddler's rescue heroes play area from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.. Food vendors will be available all day. The Marshall County Cancer Foundation (MCCF) is a 501(c)(3)non-profit organization.

The Foundation is governed by a Board of Directors consisting of people with a variety of experience and expertise, who volunteer their time and resources. and a solution that fit both parties could be reached. agreed Aldermen to defer the vote until

more information could be gathered. Also moved to a fu-

ture meeting was a final vote on revised food truck license fees.

At the August meeting, a food truck owner explained to the board that, as it stood, Chapel Hill's permitting fees were far and above any comparable municipality for food trucks. The town did not have an ordinance for food

trucks, meaning they fell under transient vendor permits, which cost \$50 every two weeks per location.

> In response, the town drafted the ordinance which would set permit fees for trucks at \$120 per year.

> Lopez said that his licensing fees were much higher and questioned the fairness of such a low fee.

Newly sworn in Aldermen Benjamin Piper said that the proposed

lower fee for food trucks "felt like a slap in the face for our brick and mortar folks."

Aldermen agreed to gather more information and address the issue in the future.

In other business, the board approved joining the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement Service to provide pension and 401k retirement services for the town's employees.

The board also unanimously chose Alderman Marion Joyce to continue in the role of vice mayor for another two year term.
