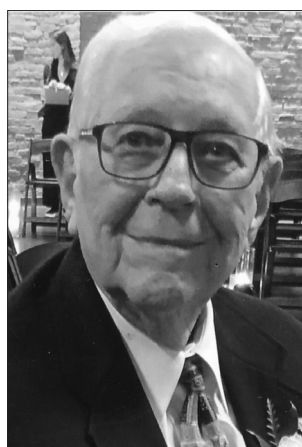


Obituaries
