



The City of Lewisburg is seeking a finance professional to be their next City Treasurer. The City Treasurer is an appointed position responsible for all City General Funds averaging \$11 to \$12 million dollars and answers directly to the City Council. Position is under the general administrative direction of and evaluated by the City Manager. The position is responsible for the supervision of others and directs the financial activities of the City in budgeting, accounting, purchasing, tax collections, etc. Budgeting, accounts payable/receivable, debt and cash management, and pension management are a high priority. The City Treasurer also directs operational activities of the City in fleet management, information services, municipal court, and collaborates with the City Manager on other related work as required.

Candidates should possess a Bachelor's degree of Business Administration, Accounting, Finance, or closely related field; Master's degree preferred. In lieu of a Bachelor's degree, a candidate should possess a minimum of eight (8) years or more of relevant experience, preferably in public accounting and finance or closely related field. Three (3) to five (5) years of progressively responsible management experience in accounting and financial management required, preferably in public sector. Certified Government Finance Manager (CGFM), Certified Public Finance Officer (CPFO) or CPA with a minimum of five (5) years of primarily governmental experience with at least three (3) of those years in the State of Tennessee is preferred.
