

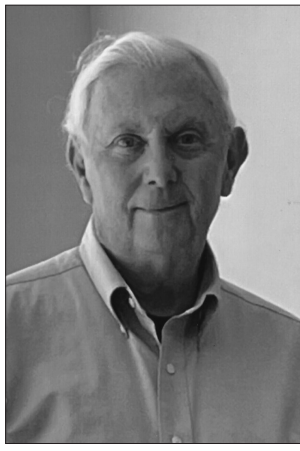
Obituaries
