- H-** Have a clean windshield to ensure visibility of pedestrians and other vehicles as you drive through neighborhoods.
- A-** Avoid fast driving in and around neighborhoods and don't pass stopped vehicles, they may be dropping off passengers.
- L-** Leave costumes and apparel that doesn't fit properly at home or the store.
- L-** Look both ways before crossing the street.
- O-** Only buy costumes labeled "flame-retardant." This means the material won't burn.
- W-** Wear comfy shoes When walking a great deal, comfy shoes are a must! Shoelaces should be double-knotted so nobody trips in the dark!
- E-** Ensure your costume allows you to see clearly!
- E-** Eat candy only after your parents check it.
- N-** Never go trick-or-treating alone. Always go in a group and stay together!



LOOK IN ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE CROSSING THE STREET
Obey all traffic signals. Walk, never run, across the street, and use sidewalks.
