#### **AMTRAK TO STOP DEC. 15** City sees 15-year effort rewarded with ribbon cutting on new depot

FORT MADISON – A slight sprinkle and chilly wind did nothing to take away from the celebration of community as the Southwest Chief stopped westbound for the first time at the city's new Amtrak depot Friday night. Mayor Matt Mohrfeld stepped off to cheers as he waived to hundreds that had piled onto the new passenger platform in historic downtown Fort Madison. Mohrfeld also thanked the former and current council members for taking the project and putting it over the fence.

"This isn't about getting on a train and stepping off, it's a lot bigger than that. It was about finding the money, the backing, the vision, and bringing this across the finish

"History is made," Mohrfeld said as he was handed a microphone from Amtrak Public Relations Manager Marc Magliari.

"If it wasn't for the mayors championing this, and I want to see Brad (Randolph's) hand in the air and John Wright's hand in the air, the Steve Ireland family with their hands in the air." line," Mohrfeld said.

Ken Kempker, Ireland's son, spoke for the Ireland family with the backdrop of the Chief sitting at the Steven J. Ireland Memorial Depot.

"This is dad's vision and it's amazing to see this. Thank you, everyone. I know he's looking down on us and he's extremely happy," Kempker said.

# Lady Hounds' poor shooting leads to first loss of season

Ross scores 16 of her 18 in second half

FORT MADISON – The drought was long and costly.

And it left Fort Madison's girls basketball team scrambling throughout the second half of Friday's 46-38 home loss to Fairfield.

Fort Madison (3-1) went without a field goal for the final nine minutes of the first half as Fairfield (3-1) built a 26-14 halftime lead.

The Bloodhounds tried to rally in the second half, getting to within five points twice. But Fairfield was able to close out the win.

"I thought we had some good looks," Fort Madison coach Tony Sargent said. "We just didn't make any of them. When you've got layups and good shots that don't fall, they just don't fall. You can account it to whatever, but we just didn't make shots.

"If we had made some shots early and been closer, maybe things would have been different."

"I thought we played good team defense," Fairfield coach Pat Pacha said. Pacha said the Trojans' main goal was to try to slow Fort Madison leading scorer Malarie Ross. Ross finished with 18 points, but 16 of those came in the second half. Ross' only first-half points came on two free throws.

"Anna Dunlap, one of the quickest players for us, had one job, and that was to deny Malarie Ross the ball as much as possible," Pacha said. "I thought she did a good job of that, and when Ross did get away, we did a good job of closing out with help."

Ross hit a 3-pointer with 6:05 to play that got Fort Madison within 36-31. The two teams traded baskets before the Trojans went on a 6-0 run to put the game away.

Sargent said the Bloodhounds are still a work in progress.

"I thought we did a good job," Sargent said. "The effort was there. We didn't foul when we should have, we didn't push the ball as hard as we should have. It's just going to take time.

"We just need to keep working at it. And by the middle of January, the first of February, we'll have it figured out."

"Tony's got a good defensive team too," Pacha said. "We scored 46, or whatever, and we played great defense. We'll take it."

Bloodhounds capture 2nd place wrestling short-handed at Missouri tourney

WENTZVILLE, Mo. - Fort Madison is finding some luck wrestling south of the border.

Last year the Bloodhounds took the title at the Liberty Duals in St. Charles and on Saturday three Fort Madison wrestlers earned first place in their division at the Liberty Wentzville Tournament at Wentzville's Liberty High School.

Sophomores Teague Smith and Ike Thacher and senior Jakob McGowan all took home the top medal, but maybe just as impressive was the fact that all three went through their brackets pinning every opponent they faced, going a combined 14-0 on the day.

"It doesn't happen happen often," said Head Coach Ryan Smith said.

Teague Smith rolled through the 170 lb bracket with four pins. He took on Fulton's Elijah Brocksmith in the title match and won by fall just 14 seconds into the second period. His first two wins were in less than a minute over wrestlers from Centralia and Palmyra. He knocked off Alex O'Connor out of St. Charles West with nine seconds left in the first period.

McGowan, who had the highest finish for the Hounds at last weekend's Keen Invitational in Independence at 182 lbs, put his first three opponents to the mat in less than minute each including a 14 second pin over Carson Rauner of Ladue Horton Watkins in the third round of pool play.

Head Coach Ryan Smith said it wasn't an issue of a competition.

We preach pin the other guy," Smith said. "I think we made it look easy, but those opponents weren't bad. They were solid kids and those three guys were really wrestling well."

Smith said quick pins don't necessarily transition to a lot of points for the wrestlers, which some wrestlers strive for.

"Some wrestlers try to haul in points, but something we put an emphasis on is putting shoulders to mats."

But Smith said he was impressed with the Hounds abilities to get repeated pins on Saturday so far from home.

Wrestling at 190 sophomore Ike Thacher breezed through his first two matches by fall in under a minute each, and then had to go into the second period before getting Jose Juarez of Palmyra 32 seconds into the second period.

Thacher then scored another pin over Sullivan's Jordan Rice at 1:46 of the first period to get the title at 190.

The Hounds recorded 29 pins on the day out of 48 total matches including the sweeps by Smith, McGowan and Thacher

The Hounds last wrestled at the Wentzville tourney two years ago and came home with a ninth-place finish. Smith said they didn't wrestle very well in 2019 but he liked the Hounds chances of winning the team scoring outright had a full team made the trip. The Hounds were missing ranked senior Gavin Wiseman who had scheduled ACTs and couldn't make the trip.

"I remember feeling like we didn't represent ourselves very well leaving there two years ago. But I think if we have had Gavin there and maybe Austin Miller we could have won the event," he said. "But I'd call taking second place not having a full team a positive," he said.

Aiden Pennock and Henry Wiseman both took 3rd place. Smith said Pennock has been improving all year, and Wiseman looked as good as he has all vear.

"He was really strong on top and showed a lot of offense," he said. "He had a rough tournament at Independence so that was good to see on his part."

Daniel Sokolik and Logan Pennock each claimed fifth-place medals at 220



and 120 lbs. respectively Emmett Kruse placed 6th at 126.

Year's Day. (Code of Iowa, Sec. 123.49[2b] & 123.150) SECTION 2. SEVER-

ABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 80.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Donnellson, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

80.03 NOTICE BY MAIL. A police authority or private entity that takes into custody an abandoned vehicle shall send notice by certified mail that the vehicle has been taken into custody no more than twenty days after taking custody of the vehicle. Notice shall be sent to the last known address of record of the last known registered owner of the vehicle, all lienholders of record, and any other known claimant to the vehicle. Notice shall be deemed given when mailed. The notice shall include all of the following: A description of the year, make, model and vehicle identification number of the vehicle. The location of the facility where the vehicle is being held. Information for the persons receiving the notice of their right to reclaim the vehicle and personal property contained therein within ten days after the effective date of the notice. Persons may reclaim the vehicle or personal property upon payment of all towing, preservation, and storage charges resulting from placing the vehicle in custody and upon payment of the costs of notice required pursuant to this subsection. A statement that failure of the owner, lienholders, or claimants to exercise their right to reclaim the vehicle or personal property within the time provided shall be deemed a waiver by

the owner, lienholders, and claimants of all right, title, claim and interest in the vehicle or personal property. A statement that failure to reclaim the vehicle or personal property is deemed consent for the police authority or private entity to sell the vehicle at a public auction or dispose of the vehicle to a demolisher and to dispose of the personal property by sale or destruction. If the abandoned vehicle was taken into custody by a private entity without a police authority's initiative, the notice shall state that the private entity may claim a garage keeper's lien as described in Section 321.90, subsection 1 of the Code of Iowa, and may proceed to sell or dispose of the vehicle. If the abandoned vehicle was taken into custody by a police authority or by a private entity hired by a police authority, the notice shall state that any person claiming rightful possession of the vehicle or personal property who disputes the planned disposition of the vehicle or personal property by the police authority or private entity or of the assessment of fees and charges provided by this section may ask for an evidentiary hearing before the police authority to contest those matters. If the persons receiving notice do not ask for a hearing or exercise their right to reclaim the vehicle or personal property within the ten-day reclaiming period, the owner, lienholders, or claimants shall no longer have any right, title, claim, or interest in or to the vehicle or the personal property. A court in any case in law or equity shall not recognize any right, title, claim, or interest of the owner, lienholders, or claimants after the expiration of the ten-day reclaiming period. (Code of Iowa, Sec.

# Fort Madison boys stay perfect with win over Fairfield

But a rotation of eight seniors has learned how to finish games.

That kind of maturity has helped Fort Madison get off to a 3-0 start, and the key, Wilson said, is you don't know who is going to lead the way.

In this game it was Reiburn Turnbull, who hit his first two 3-pointers of the game and finished with a game-high 21 points.

"The kid's capable of doing that," Wilson said. "He's capable of having those kind of nights. He can shoot. When he is catching and shooting in the right way all of the time, he's going to make them."

Turnbull's last 3-pointer came with 2:32 to play, putting Fort Madison up 50-40. Miles Dear added an up-and-under layup seconds later, and the Hounds led 52-43.

Fort Madison then closed the game by making nine of their last 12 free throws.

Dear added 16 for the Bloodhounds.

"That's the thing about this group — eight deep and they're all seniors," Wilson said. "The great thing is you don't know who is going to step up on a given night. Any of them can do something. That's what makes this group fun. Anyone can show up on a given night."

Fort Madison dominated the first half. The Bloodhounds held the Trojans to just one first-quarter field goal and had a 28-12 halftime lead.

But Fort Madison scored just four third-quarter points as Fairfield rallied.

"Our offense was bad the first three minutes," Wilson said. "We were up 16 at half, and if we could have gotten up by 20 we could have pushed them away. But they got back into it."

Now, though, Fort Madison knows how to close. "It's just the difference in maturity," Wilson said

# Officials go deep on meaning, potential of depot project

#### **DEPOT** - Continued from Page 1

first put forth by John Wright and went to work putting together support at local, state, and federal levels to start working toward bringing a historical depot back to the Fort Madison riverfront.

It was a project that, to this day, sits as the legacy of Ireland's mayoral service prior to his death in 2012.

Kempker said as much as his father wanted this project for the community, there were some personal motivations, as well. A granite sign was placed on the west side of the depot in 2012 naming the depot after Steve.

"As much as he wanted to do this for the community he was always taking us on trips as kids to Chicago and St. Louis. It was important for him to see what's outside of Fort Madison, but it was also about bringing people into Fort Madison," Kempker said.

Ireland's other children, Tony, Drake, Steve, Jr., and Charles were also on hand for the ceremony.

"After his dad, our grandpa Harvey, passed away. (Harvey) worked for the railroad and part of those benefits was that grandma could travel anywhere in the country in Amtrak. So they used to go out to California and back and all around on Amtrak when he was a little kid," Charles said.

Those trips included Steve's siblings Craig Ireland, David Slee, and Alan Slee, his brothers, and Amy Coffey his sister.

"As many obstacles as there has been, there's a little closure here for us. So it's just a beautiful thing," Kempker said.

"It's kind of insane to see through the years with all the obstacles that generations of mayors have piggy backed this and it's finally become a reality," Tony said.

"This was personal for dad. Our grandpa Harvey worked in this building. When he decided to take this up it wasn't only for the citizens of Fort Madison. His dad worked there and it's going to help the community, so let's do it," Steve Ireland, Jr. said.

City officials, including Councilmen Tom Schulz, Rusty Andrews, and Chad Cangas, and councilwoman Donna Amandus joined Mohrfeld and Public Works Director Mark Bousselot on the morning boarding of the train to Galesburg where city officials there joined the delegation for lunch.

On the way to Galesburg, Mohrfeld talked about his ideas to build on the momentum.

"My concept is to build a relationship with Galesburg by sending them people to visit and when they start seeing that, then they're gonna say, "What's this about" and then they will come to us and maybe we get overnights," he said.

"But this is all consumption driven. Eat, drink, shop, and come home.

"Unless you do this, it's hard to visualize riding this train. Eating lunch - going to three or four shops and coming back. Right across the street there's a really odd health food coop/grocery store and unless you walk through it, it's not for everybody, but it's for somebody, and we don't have one."

now you get into Kansas City at something crazy like 10:30 p.m.. You pretty much get to hotel check-in and you're done for that night."

Mohrfeld said he couldn't really speak to the vision of the previous mayors, but said the timing of the depot opening is pretty good.

"Even though this has taken forever to bring on-line. It makes more sense now than it did even six years ago. Now, you're looking at a few new businesses downtown, a new street, riverfront revitalization, a depot. It has a different feel than it would even half a dozen years ago," he said.

Andrews said time will tell on what impact that relocated depot will have on Fort Madison.

"It's guaranteed it's in a whole lot better place than it was. The location is beautiful. It turned out amazing. It's downtown and I think one of the thing it hurts a little bit is the time the train arrives and leaves from Illinois. It's not very promoting for tourism showing up at 7:30 p.m," he said.

"But the road project, the depot project, the parking lot at 7th Street, all those things make the downtown come together. We need to keep doing what we're doing with Avenue H and, sooner or later, make something happen with downtown and Avenue G with improvements."

Schulz said the investment was worth the effort. "The city's investment in this, I think, has been minimal and so well-spent. We've protected a great asset," he said.

"But I've become reinvigorated with this whole idea today. Do I think this depot is going to be great boon to downtown - maybe not short-term, but maybe long-term because I think we're going to be moving with more mass transit."

"There were so many negotiated things throughout the process during a changing regulatory climate. The goal posts kept moving and every time the goal posts moved, the price got higher," he said."

"Delays, extended construction - when you look at the original scope of the project and what it was and you look at it now, it morphed into something so much bigger and more complicated.

"It wasn't because of us, but the things that changed around us. But I couldn't be happier for the Ireland family. You become very close to them through Steve, through his passing. And they always looked back and would check in with me. Sometimes I didn't have great news for them or any news for them. But it means so much to that family and I couldn't be happier for the community."

At one point Randolph said he was ready to acquiesce and kill the project at the direction of the council. Former Councilman Chris Greenwald, who had a close relationship with Ireland while on the council as well, put wind back in Randolph's sails.

At one point Greenwald told the council if they were going to kill the depot project, the city should also shutter the Old Fort. The argument at the time was the city was putting a lot of money into a project that didn't have a solid return on investment.

Greenwald said the city had been propping up the Old Fort, which also has a historical poor return on investment. However with the American Cruise Lines now making stops spring through fall at the city pier, that operation has become more viable. But Greenwald said he was a no vote on the depot relocation for the first three years.

The recently-signed Investment in Infrastructure and Jobs Act pumps \$66 billion over the next five years into passenger rail service and Derrick James, a government affairs officer with Amtrak, told Mohrfeld that the Federal Rail Administration will be developing a 5-year plan around that stimulus, and lobbying for additional stops or routes for smaller communities is not a bad idea.

"There is \$66 billion over the next 5 years in investment in rails. New cars and locomotives will come out of that money. We want to do a lot of expansion that's been proposed and that includes routes," James said.

"The money is more geared toward the train's sweet spot which is trips of two to five hours. These trains run to connect our rural communities. Where our business is growing, and where trains can have the most impact is connecting cities of about two to five hours apart. So two major cities like Chicago and St. Louis or Chicago and the Twin Cities, that's where we're going to be focusing all that expansion effort."

Mohrfeld said it's the potential of those different routes and stops that could be most beneficial to Fort Madison. "Different routes really play into what he's saying. Right saying it was both personal to him and a project that tells the region that Fort Madison is still open for business, and allowing the depot project to fail sends a completely different message.

"It's probably a little bit overwhelming," Randolph said looking out into the darkness sitting in the lounge car as the Chief sped toward Fort Madison.

"In the moment when you're working on the project, when you're doing the daily and weekly tasks, it seemed all-consuming. This project looked into the abyss multiple times. You get changes in attitudes and opinion and leadership. It was a struggle to pull that through to the finish."

Randolph said there were times when people on different sides of the project fell off the radar, and the project would hit a wall.

Then he said Ray Lang, an Amtrak official in charge of state supported services, drove to Fort Madison from Chicago and walked into City Hall and apologized for how the project had fallen apart.

"He said 'I'm going to make sure, with your help, we get this project done.' And from that moment on, I was reinflated. It was a new approach from Amtrak. But Ray

"For two to three years, I kept voting no, and Brad and I were out on patrol one night and talked and I said I gotta get convicted about this," Greenwald said.

He said with the way that council was shaping up, he could have been the deciding vote to kill the project years back. But conversations with Randolph, and councilmen Neal Boeding and Bob Chestnut changed his mind.

"We're all just dominoes in this project and we had to fall when we had to fall to make all the other dominoes fall," Greenwald said.

"This is an entire community victory. This isn't my victory, even though at one point it was just me and (Randolph) carrying the ball, that was just our time and our job. That's why I'm excited about this. This is everybody's victory."

Greenwald also pointed to North Lee County Historical Society's Andy Andrews for ushering the preservation of the museum, which houses the depot on the east side of the building.

"If he hadn't fought to preserve that depot, we wouldn't be on this train." Greenwald said.
