SCC duo form baseball academy in Fort Madison

FORT MADISON - A new effort is underway in southeast Iowa to bring skills training to youth baseball and softball players.

The Southeast Iowa Baseball Training Academy has opened an indoor training facility in Fort Madison and is looking for players that want to focus on the finer skills of baseball and softball.

Originally created as a baseball academy to help kids learn the finer points of baseball, Ron Walker, one of the founders of the academy, said parents quickly began to inquire about girls softball.

"We're three weeks into this program," Walker said. "It kind of branched off from the Southeast Iowa Junior Blackhawks. We started that about three years ago as a change to the travel ball culture in southeast Iowa."

Walker said Southeastern Community College coach Justin Schulte asked him about three years ago if he would be interested in coaching a new team as another option to the Burlington Xplosion youth league franchise based out of Burlington.

"He was looking for a change in that culture and his son was playing for the Xplosion. He asked me

to coach and I took that position and the interest started growing and we started the Southeast Iowa Junior Blackhawks. We had more than 60 kids show up for the initial tryouts from multiple towns, from Carthage to Mt. Pleasant and up past Mediapolis," Walker said.

Two years into the new youth program, which has teams from the 8 and under division up to the 14 and under, Walker said more and more people started asking about lessons and instruction.

"When we started hearing people wanted us to expand Junior Blackhawks from 8U to 14U, we also started fielding request from parents for additional instruction, so we formed this academy. We were able to work with Tony and Tara Johnson in Fort Madison to use their indoor training facility and we started holding training sessions about three weeks ago," he said.

As part of the academy, Schulte and Walker along with a few other volunteers, work with the kids in hour-long sessions from 6 to 7 p.m. on Sundays and Mondays. SCC hitting coach John McVey and pitching coach Daniel Peterson also come down to camps at different times to work with academy kids.

Alton appointed to conservation board

MONTROSE - A Donnellson woman has been appointed to the Lee County Conservation Board.

During Tuesday morning's regular meeting of the Lee County Board of Supervisors, Liza Alton of Donnellson was appointed to sit on the board that's been mired on controversy since banning permanent duck blinds earlier this year.

Alton is a substitute teacher in the Central Lee school system and has served stints on the Lee County Fair Board, Lee County Pork Producers Board of Directors, and served on several committees with the National Pork Board.

Bernie McCauley of West Point cautioned the board to consider someone who has a background and passion for hunting in Lee County.

"I have been attending the conservation board meetings since, what you label as controversy, began, starting with the duck blinds," he said. "There is an admitted lack of knowledge on the current board of hunters and hunting, and between bird hunters, duck hunters, and deer hunters. I think it represents a fair percentage of the population of groups that use the conservation areas."

McCauley said he's sure the current board has done a great job in relation to parks and other conservation property.

"I'm sure the current board does a great job with issues relating to parks and some of the other things, but I was going to appeal to the board to consider an application of a hunter so that input could be given to the board directly and that knowledge could be used in decisions the board makes," he said.

Supervisor Don Hunold reminded the board that the state has encouraged all local governmental agencies

to be as gender neutral in their appointments as possible. He also said Alton represents an area of the county typically not represented on the conservation board.

"We have one lady on the board from the Wever area, one guy from Fort Madison, and three guys from the Montrose/Keokuk area," Hunold said. "Liza Alton is from north Donnellson and that area as far as I can tell has not been covered. She is also a lady and having the board

Climax officials looking into Monday lab fire

FORT MADISON - The first that broke out at a Climax Molybdenum lab on Monday afternoon is still under investigation, according to company officials.

Eric Kinneberg, director of external communications for Freeport McMoRan, the parent company for Climax, issued a single statement on the fire Tuesday evening.

"A fire broke out in the Climax Ft. Madison lab at approximately 2:20 p.m. yesterday. The Ft. Madison Fire Department and Montrose Fire Department responded to the fire, which was extinguished at approximately 3:00 p.m. the same day. No injuries were sustained. The cause of the fire is under investigation," Kinneberg wrote in an email to

Pen City Current.

Fort Madison Fire Chief Joey Herren said the fire appeared to have broken out in a lab and got into the ventilation hood and up near the roof.

"There was fire in the lab and it got up into the hoods near the roof of the building," Herren said. "We had to ventilate the roof to get at the vent hoods. All we had was a basic structure fire, nothing as far as hazardous materials."

An "all call" for Fort Madison firefighters was put out at about 2:30 and a call was also put out for mutual aid from the Montrose Fire Department.

"We were trying to get ahead of it as fast as we could," Herren said, and then referred all other comments to company officials.

Lee County EMS and the Lee County Sheriff assisted at the scene.

gender neutral is a good thing. We don't have anybody in that direction that's ever applied and with that I'd make a motion to approve Liza Alton for the conservation board."

Rick Larkin agreed that adding a woman to the board would be a good thing and said all three were qualified to be on the board. The motion to appoint a board member was tabled at the last meeting, after Supervisor Ron Fedler moved to appoint Michael Clark to the board. A vote on that motion was never taken.

"I said the same thing last week," Fedler said. "I think all three are well qualified, but we can only choose one, but I wanted it known that I had been talking about it in my district."

Larkin reminded the supervisors that the conservation board members are in staggered appointments so one person is appointed each year.

"They should reapply if they really want to be on it if they aren't chosen this year," he said before the vote.

The board also re-appointed Paula Spiekermeier and Judy Bartachek to the Lee County Board of Health.

In other action, the board approved an amendment and appropriations to the fiscal year 2018 budget to help offset increased maintenance costs for the Lee County buildings as a result of repairs being done on the South Lee County Courthouse. The motion passed 4-1 with Fedler voting against the move.

"We kind of opened this on a trial basis to see how it would go," Walker said. "Monday night was our fourth session. We started with baseball but as word got out we immediately had parents asking us about softball."

The first Monday session was marked by three different hitting stations where about 10 kids rotated through the stations in cycles focusing on hand and eye coordination, body positioning, and bat

speed.

Walker said he expects the academy to grow after the holidays as that is when travel ball clubs start setting schedules and gearing up for the season.

But Walker said the academy is for everyone, even those that want to work on skills for other leagues or just have an interest in learning the game. Right now boys and girls are being integrated together in the camps, but as interest grows Walker

said he hopes to have separate boys and girls sessions.

He said each session will be limited to 10 kids per session, but if the interest level warrants additional classes, the academy would look at adding those.

Costs of the sessions are \$20/hour, but the academy will be running monthly specials and those interested are encouraged to visit the Facebook page regularly for them.




