Two suspects, one arrest in statue theft

DONNELLSON - Donnellson police have made one arrest and are on the lookout for a suspect in connection with the recent theft of statues in Lee and Van Buren counties in Iowa.

According to a Wednesday evening press release from Donnellson/West Point Police Chief Brad Roberts, on August 1st, 2017, the Donnellson Police Department obtained arrest warrants for persons suspected of stealing a bronze statue from the Railroad Park in Donnellson.

Information regarding the theft of the statue was investigated over the course of the past 10 days and led officers to evidence supporting the request for arrest warrants on Skylah Christine Beach, 25, of Burlington, and Gregory Michael Crall Jr., 32, also of Burlington.

In the early morning hours of July 23rd, 2017, suspects stole a bronze statue from Railroad Park in Donnellson. The statue, valued at over \$4000 was labeled "Lazy Days" and located in a flower bed in the park. Suspects tied a chain around the statue and dragged the statue from its location, north on Main St., to a gravel road in Lee County, where the statue

Last year Rebecca opened "The Budding Artist" at 307 N 36th Suite 108 in Quincy. The space can fit up to 25 and specializes in ceramics glazing, raw clay building, and painting parties. In a way, the space found her. After eight years of corporate retail, Rebecca was ensnared in an annual inventory, in which regional managers

from certain districts swoop in like monkey warriors from Wizard of Oz. The horde attacks and has no understanding of her issues in a smaller town with a high selling division. Not even reprieve for lunch, so Rebecca heads out of the store to her car and into a fast food lot. From there she ups the rpms to an empty lot across from the drive thru to eat in peace. When arising

from the wrapper, she sees the empty store space for rent. The rest is history. She sums up her style the best.

"My name is Rebecca Butler. I am the owner of The Budding Artist, a pottery and painting studio in Quincy, IL. I received my BFA in Studio Art from Quincy University, where I also, currently teach Ceramics.

I grew up in an artistic

family, learning at an early age, to appreciate the "art" that surrounds us, whether it was a beautiful sunset on the river, a flowering weed growing out of the sidewalk, or a homeless woman in New Orleans. There is beauty in almost everything.

I don't have a certain subject matter for my paintings, if it catches

Tri State Rodeo needs Lil' cowpokes

FORT MADISON - The 25th Annual Lil' Spurs Rodeo will be held on Monday, September 4th at the Tri State Rodeo grounds in Fort Madison.

The annual event is for children, 3 - 14, and includes Mutton Bustin' Calf Riding, Stick Horse Barrel Racing, Goat Tail Tie, Greased Pig Contest and Calf Scramble.

The event is sponsored annually by Shottenkirk Automotive Group, Kempker's True Value and Just Ask Rental, Fort Madison Community Hospital and Pepsi.

Pre-Registration is required. Forms are due by Monday August 28th. Online registration only and forms can be found at www.tristaterodeo.org.

Check in time for pre-registered contestants will be

from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. at the Rodeo Pavilion, at the north end of the rodeo grounds, on Monday September 4th. Each pre-registered contestant will receive a free t-shirt. The event will begin at 10:00 a.m.



The event has grown significantly each year with over 300 contestants and a crowd of over 1,500 people. Admission to Lil' Spurs Rodeo is the cost of a \$5.00 rodeo button. Buttons are on sale now at Fort Madison area businesses, the Tri State Rodeo ticket office, and the day of the Lil' Spurs Rodeo at the gates.

The favorite of the spectators is the Mutton Bustin' event for children ages 3-8 and less than 55 pounds. Contestants will show their talent by hanging on and riding a sheep for six seconds. This event is judged and the top 18-rated cowpokes will be invited back to ride again during Tri-State Rodeo performances, Thursday – Saturday with the contestant receiving the highest score each performance winning a silver buckle.

Also, for the younger cowpokes, is the Stick Horse



Barrel Race. This is a timed event for children ages 3-6, they will use stick horses (provided by the rodeo) and run their ponies through a mini barrel pattern. The fastest time in each age group wins a silver buckle.

The calf riding event is for children 8-14 and is also a timed and judged event. This event is divided into two age groups 8-11 and 12-14. The finals for this event will take place on Monday immediately after the Lil' Spurs Rodeo and the winner of each age group will receive a buckle.

The Goat Tail Tie contest is for ages 7-9 and the contestant will begin from a starting line and tie a ribbon around the goat's tail, vying for the fastest time and a buckle.

There are two events which always entertain the crowd. The Greased Pig Contest for ages 6-14 divided in age groups 6-8, 9-10, and ages 11-14. The Calf Scramble for ages 9-14 and is divided in age groups 9-11 and 12-14. Each age group winner will receive a buckle.

my eye, I try to capture it for a later painting. I break the cardinal sin in art with my paintings...I work from photographs! I am too slow of a painter to try to capture it from life. But that also allows me to work from multiple photos, which makes it easier for me to get a more dimensional and realistic painting.

Every clay piece I make is unique and one of a kind. I love the lumps and bumps that other potters see as imperfections. I use them to my advantage and change the design to accommodate the natural lines of the clay. The process I use for creating my work, both clay and painted, is really quite simple:

ClayPainting

- Roll out wet clay with a rolling pin - Go thru all the pictures on your phone
- Press in texture Get distracted by your Disney vacation
- Keep the cat from walking on - Choose an
