



# Grant County At a Glance

Grant County
Grant County is located in the
High Plains Region in the southwestern corner of Kansas, with its
western edge being 40 miles from
the Colorado state line and its
southern edge 60 miles from the
Oklahoma border. Grant County
sits on top of the world famous
Hugoton gas field, one of the
world's largest deposits of natural
gas. The field spans over 4,800
square miles.

### Government

The county is governed by a three-member board of commissioners, with the chairman elected at large. The City of Ulysses is governed by a Mayor and a six-member council, along with a city clerk and a city administrator.

### **Voter Registration**

To register to vote, go to the Grant County Courthouse, located at 108 S. 


Grant County is named after Ulysses S. Grant, the 18th President of the United States.

Ulysses is the county seat of Grant County. The first Ulysses town site was founded in June 1885. It was located approximately 2 miles east of present day Ulysses. After attempting and being unable to pay off a considerable amount of debt, the town was moved to its present location. The move began in February 1909 and was finished in June 1909.






### Grant County Cemeteries

With the growing interest in Genealogy, cometaries, especially older sites, are popular places to visit or research. Many enjoy the old headstones and their epitiaphs and designs, whether searching for ancestors or not. Grant County has four cameteries.

Ullysses Cemetery

Located three miles east of town on Highway 160.

### Golden Cametery

Located seven miles south on Kansas Highway 25 to Road 19. Turn west and go approximately five and abalf miles and the cemetery will be on the north side of the road, or you can take Highway 160 west five miles to Road E, turns outh for seven miles, then turn west on Road 19 and look to the north.

#### Shockey Cametany

Located north of Ulysses. To reach it, drive west for seven miles on Highway 160. Turn north on Read Cand drive six and a half miles. A sign will directly out approximately a half mile cast to the cemetary site.



### Zionville Cameteny

Located south nine miles on K25 to the Wagonbed Springs Road. Costraight where the road curves. Follow fit approximately two miles to Road 22 and turn west for half a mile. You will see the cemetery on the north side of the road.

Another gravesite point of interest is the grave of Mary E. Hurst, located tenumiles cast of Ulysses, just south of Highway 160 off Roads. Protested by a pipe fence, the gravesite can be seen from the highway when not surrounded by crops. Mary died Hebruary 1,1833 at the age of 40 and has been laid to rest at the same site since.

Permission was asked to move the grave to a formal site but some of the family objected.

# HISTORIC WAGON BED SPRINGS

### HISTORICAL MARKER

About two miles west were the Lower Springs of the Cimarron River, known today as Wagon Bed Springs. For early-day travelers on the famous Santa Fe Trail, the springs were an "oasis" in dry weather. Several shortcuts of the trail converged here, with the most popular route running between here and the Arkansas River near the present-day town of Cimarron. The sixty-mile stretch between the two rivers, known as the Jornada, was a perilous route for men and animals in dry seasons when wagon trains often ran out of water. Near here in 1831, the noted western explorer and fur trader Jedediah Smith. after being lost and without water for four days, was killed by Comanches just as he reached the river.

Late in the history of the trail a wagon bed was

Late in the history of the trail a wagon bed was set in the ground to collect water from one of the springs. The springs take their name from that event.

Despite the importance of this famous camping place, today there are few visible remains of the many travelers who once stayed here. In nearby areas, however, trail ruts can still be seen, left by the many wagons that traversed the trail.



Known today as Wagon Bed Springs, Lower Cimarron Springs, located on the Cimarron River in southern Grant County, afforded the first water during the dry season on the 60 mile stretch of the desert or Cimarron Cut-off Route of the Santa Fe Trail, after crossing and leaving the Arkansas River. It was the stopping place of all desert route of the Trail. The National travelers over the Service designated the springs a National Historic Landmark in

Located on the most dangerous stretch of the journey to Santa Fe, the Springs were an oasis on the route followed by most travelers to Santa Fe prior to the Mexican War. Not only were the springs a welcome site to thirsty travelers, but they also served as a watering spot for immense herds of buffalo and prairie animals, as well as for Indians of the area. More than 500 men and officers of the Mormon Battalion camped at the Springs in September 1846. Volunteering to fight in the War of 1846 against Mexico, they pledged their army pay to help finance the establishment of the mormon church in Utah. They were not required to wear the army uniform and were not furnished mounts. Most of them marched on foot all the way from Fort Leavenworth to Santa Fe and then on to California.

Cimarron Springs (Wagon Bed Springs) Camp Site encompasses approximately 195 acres of privately-owned property. Tours of the area can be arranged for groups or individuals through the Wagon Bed Springs Chapter/Santa Fe Trail Association, 620-356-1854, or Grant County Museum, 620-356-3009. ### HISTORIC ADOBE MUSEUM









The premier Historic Adobe Museum in Ulysses is steeped in history right down to the building it is housed in. The adobe building, built in the 1930s, is amazing given the circumstances of the era and the tenacity of the people who constructed it. The adobe building, constructed in 1937-38 as a machine shop for Grant County, was one of six WPA projects funded in Grant County between 1935-1938. The walls are composed of adobe blocks laid with mud mortar. Upon completion, the exterior adobe walls were covered with cement stucco and whitewashed. During the 1970s, the adobe county shop building was converted to a museum and the whitewashed adobe walls were painted a buff clay color, more in step with natural adobe. Adobe fireplaces with brick hearths stand in the two front

The museum has evolved to a gallery-style look with artifacts placed in natural settings, making this premier museum a must-see for all museum enthusiasts. The displays are enhanced with murals by artist Larry Britton. Visitors are treated to scenic panoramas that tell the story of life on the High Plains and give a glimpse into the lifestyle of the nomadic Indians and adventurous pioneers who settled the area. An Indian encampment, a sod house and a freight wagon loaded with trade goods are just a few of the tableaus created in the Museum gallery for viewing life in southwest Kansas from the mid-1880s to the

rooms.

present. The Hotel Edwards, built in 1887 in Old
Ulysses, was cut into three sections and moved along
with the entire town to the site of New Ulysses in 1909.
Complete with period furnishings, it is now located at
the museum complex. The District #1
one-room school, also authentically furnished and on
museum grounds, is used by area schools to enhance
field trip experiences.

The museum features special exhibits throughout the year and hosts Holiday Open Houses the first two Sundays in December.

### **Grant County Airport**



The Grant County Airport has been at their current location for the last 16 years, North of Ulysses at 801 West Airport Boulevard. The airport is county owned and is taken care of by the five board members and the airport manager. The building has a very nice clean lobby with two offices, a pilot's lounge, meeting area and large hanger space. Pilots and travelers have a nice clean facility to use with the restrooms and phone area open 24 hours and also 24 hour self-serve fuel station for 1001L aviation fuel. The airport has 18 T-hangers which are currently all rented out to local pilots.

The airport is used by many travelers, business personnal, commercial companies, as well as the local aircraft owners and the three businesses on the airport grounds. The business located on airport grounds are North Star Aviation, Noyer Aviation and Ulysses Air Service.

North Star Aviation is owned and operated by Steve and Samantha Rice, who lease the airport building for their FEO (Fixed Base Operation). Steve Rice is also the airport manager. Along with their staff, they take care of the day to day operations of the airport including North Star's business. Rice is also in charge of keeping up the maintenance of the building and grounds around the airport. Hours of operation are Monday through Friday 8 am - 6 p.m.

While Grant County Airport does offer many accommodations for air traffic and the public, currently there is no one that offers Charter Services. There is an airplane for rent for current pilots or student pilots only. For more information about the airport or services offered, call 620-836-5370.

### Grant County Senior Center



The Grant County Senior Center, located at 1117 E. Grant Ave. in Ulysses, offers many things to Grant County's senior citizens. They provide breakfast and lunch, weekdays, and deliver meals to housebound seniors. They can provide frozen weekend meals, disaster relief meals and special diet substitutions. They not only provide meals. They also provide advice about government programs, Plan D-Rx, financial advice, insurance counseling, diabetile, dental and eye assistance, a nurse, medication help and monitoring, nail and foot care, assessment, wound care, blood pressure monitoring, physician referral, venipunture, and help with tax and LIEP forms. Medical services sometimes require doctor's orders. They provide a housekeeping service and personal, inhome care. Those who need legal help can get access to a lawyer for private counsel, through the Senior Center. The Senior Center has a health program that includes exercise classes, access to a certified exercise special-1st, exercise equipment and a wide variety of exercises for seniors.

For a small fee, seniors can get lifeline assistance. Through the Senior Center, seniors can get access to a library, copier and fax machine, computers, billingual services, mobility aids and transportation. In addition, the Senior Center provides programs for socialization. These include games, quilting and sewing groups and fun outings. Everyone is equal, at the Senior Center.

The first Grant County Fair was held in 1948 at the Wysses rodeo grounds with exhibits in tents. The rodeo grounds at that time were located on North Main Street. In 1949, a gift of 30 acres of land was given by George and Elma Marie Daugherty for the purpose of constructing a fairgrounds. By fair time that year, the present 4-H building was built and housed the home economics exhibits. Livestock, crops and gardens were housed in tents. Over 6,000 persons attended the 1949 fair. In 1951, the 4-H building interior was completed, a lighted softball field was built, the Bit & Spur Club moved the rodeo arena to the fairgrounds and the first parade was held. Over the years, buildings and improvements have been added, including the Civic Center in 1977.






