The end of that season saw the graduation of seniors that had competed in three state championship meets but missed the chance for a fourth state meet due to the meet being cancelled due to Corona Virus concerns. The Class of 2021 girls had team finishes of 9th, 8th and 5th and the boys had team finishes of 8th and 6th place. Graduated seniors Syd Smith and Rob McManus both earned two state medals with Syd having a best state finish of 12th place and Rob placing 2nd place for his top finish. The team relied on the


