Cross Country review

Cross country season began again for Cashmere High School athletes on Monday August 23rd. Their "2020" season began on February 23rd and ended on April 1st, 2021. That season consisted of six races mostly held in Wenatchee's Walla Walla Point Park. The end of that season saw the graduation of seniors that had competed in three state championship meets but missed the chance for a fourth state meet due to the meet being cancelled due to Corona Virus concerns. The Class of 2021 girls had team finishes of 9th, 8th and 5th and the boys had team finishes of 8th and 6th place. Graduated seniors Syd Smith and Rob McManus both earned two state medals with Syd having a best state finish of 12th place and Rob placing 2nd place for his top finish. The team relied on the

Class of 2021 a lot over the last four years.

The current team has four seniors, seven juniors, nine sophomores and seven freshmen. A varsity cross country team consists of seven runners. The first five of those seven that cross the finish line score points for the team. As

in golf, the cross country team with the lowest score is the winner. The fall 2021 team has only two senior boys and two senior girls so the team will be relying on underclassmen to run well. Luckily, we have several returning underclassmen runners that did well during the Corona Virus shortened spring season. The current season is beginning a little more

normally. Athletes do not need to run with masks in practice. Races will be at a larger variety of places. The first race of the season is Saturday September 11th at the Manson Invitational. The season is scheduled to end with a State Championship meet. Hopefully, our good friends in Olympia will stay out of it and allow high school teams to have a normal season!
